We look to the Future: New doors of opportunity are or will open to Afghanistan, Africa and the Pacific Islands. The Lord is going to draw young people to join us at MO and release them into leadership. We also believe that we have a new mandate from the Lord to teach and impart the Apostolic and the Five-Fold gifts of Ephesians 4:11. We will continue to support the discipling of the nations and releasing the church into excellence for the Lord.

We also have a heart to serve the Church in New Zealand as we are all Kiwis that love our Country and want more of God here in Aotearoa.

Body Builders for Christ

A recent trip to Nepal has seen the 1000 Training Centres vision launched as many passionate Nepalese leaders run with the "baton" of training and equipping their people.

The Church in Nepal has experienced tremendous growth since early 2000s, so that the overwhelming need has been for sound Biblical discipleship and training for the influx of new believers. Warren Young reflects on his experience in Nepal during his recent trip there to help establish the first of the 1000 Equipping Centres.

My first mission to Nepal was in 2004 at the request of C. Peter Wagner; to come alongside a pastor in Bhaktapur just outside of Kathmandu, who was struggling to keep up with people getting saved. On one trip high in the Himalayas we witnessed an entire village bow their knees to Christ's offer of salvation. However the churches struggled to train the leaders, and the churches struggled to gain a sound theological foundation on which to build that is until now. Samuel Rai and Neil Mossop invited Matthew Jeffares (the Author of "Christ Gave Gifts" based on Ephesians 4) and myself to join them in launching the vision to develop 1000 Training Centres in the next 12 months.

"But to each one of us grace was given according to the measure of Christ's gift... FOR THE EQUIPPING OF THE SAINTS AND FOR THE BUILDING UP OF THE BODY OF CHRIST." Ephesians 4:7&12

We witnessed first-hand the liberality of the measure Christ gave to the hungry leaders of Nepal as they received

the conference training and teaching materials published in their own language.

For MO to begin this training for 1000 Equipping Centres vision in Pokhara is a very distinct honour because it is the place where Nepal's first church was planted in 1952.

Two separate and intense training and equipping conferences were held in the two weeks the team was there. The team was constantly amazed at the hunger for

foundational truths in the leaders. Their passion for God's activity in their lives was evidenced as they filled the altar after every message. Many received multiple gifts of the Holy Spirit.

On completion of the two training conferences, 130 leaders graduated with much enthusiasm. With the fire of the Holy Spirit in their hearts and five books of training materials they returned to their communities having signed commitments to train 2290 leaders. And many have already begun training their leaders, with heart-warming results. Pastor Timothy reports, "(The training) was so blessed for all of us. And our trainees have started to teach their own teams. May God bless you."

PROJECTS IN FOCUS

COMPLETED PROJECTS

We are delighted and so thankful to report that with God's provision and your faithful and generous support, we have been able to complete the following projects:

Laos Livelihood Training Centre: This centre provides agricultural and Bible training for village pastors and is a tremendous encouragement to these people who place their lives in the Lord's hands on a daily basis in this nation.

ASW Training Centre Kitchen: This training centre has been a work in progress for several years, the kitchen being the final part to be completed. Gkhing is so thankful and blessed that we have been able to help him complete this project.

MYANMAR New Testaments

Events of the last decade have increased worldly influences on the youth of Myanmar, who make up 20% of Myanmar's population. This has sparked a vision for 1 million Myanmar-English New Testaments to be distributed to youth across the country. MO is committed to purchasing 1000 New Testaments towards this vision.

Total Commitment: \$8000 Balance Needed: \$7500

MALE SOW Training

School of Workers (SOW) Training is a very effective discipleship training programme used extensively by our contacts in Asia and beyond. Wherever it is used, there are always converts, which helps grow and establish the church in this case among the Maldavians.

Total Commitment: \$7500 Balance needed: \$5300

ETHNIC Tibetan SOW Training

Phurpu is planning to conduct a SOW training among the groups he met on his trek to Everest last year as well as with contacts living in other regions. MO would like sponsor 4 of these at a cost of \$900 each.

Total Commitment: \$3600 Balance needed: \$2700

1000 EQUIPPING Centres in One Year

The first two of six equipping conferences was held in October. And the first of the printed materials was given out and the trained pastors have already begun imparting to their people what they learned.



This is a project of multiplication - we train 1000, who

train up to 20 leaders each which equals up to 20,000 church leaders equipped in one year.

For this project to succeed, we need to print 80,000 books & teaching materials and invite you to partner with us. We thank the Lord that we are nearly half way to our goal.

'Catch the Wind' Missions Conference

BANGKOK, THAILAND

Ethnos Asia is hosting their bi-annual Mission's Conference "Catch the Wind" from 26th to 28th February 2019 in Bangkok, Thailand. This is an opportunity to hear reports from those who work on the frontline of battle in many Access Restricted Nations of Asia (ARNA).

Early Bird Registration up to 31 December 2018 is \$435 per person. For the 3 day conference this fee includes morning and afternoon tea and lunch each day, 2 dinners, and conference materials.

Registration fee from 1 January 2019 will be \$475 per person.

You will need to arrange your own accommodation by booking online. The conference venue is Tawana Bangkok. Other Hotels nearby are: Siam Heritage, Rose Hotel, Le Meridien Hotel, Tarntawan Place, Montien Hotel, De Arni Hotel, Bangkok Christian Guesthouse.

We encourage you to prayerfully consider attending this conference which is followed by Mission Exposure Trips to various Asian nations, usually to Myanmar, Laos, Thailand, Cambodia, Vietnam and possibly China & others. Vision Trips and accommodation, are additional costs that you will need to budget for.
