DO IT AGAIN, LORD!

In January 1907, the Great Revival of Pyongyang swept through the Korean peninsula, especially the north, liberating the church and bringing many to faith. Three thousand churches sprang up in what is now known as North Korea and the now capital city, Pyongyang, was even called, 'The Jerusalem of Asia.' Amazingly, Kim Il-Sung's grandmother was a Christian and was part of that revival!

Persecution of Christians began in 1910 when Japan annexed Korea, and mandated the worship of the Japanese emperor. Christians who bowed down to his portrait were spared, but those that didn't were tortured, imprisoned and/or executed. In 1950, Kim's communist army of North Korea invaded democratic South Korea. The ensuing Korean War killed millions, leveled both North and South Korea and ended three years later in a draw, with the post-war border more or less where the pre-war border had been.

Despite the persecution which lasted 35 years until 1945, the number of Christians grew. When Japan surrendered to end the second World War, revival returned to the country.

The interval was short-lived however, as the Communists, led by the Soviet-trained Kim

Il-sung, streamed into and occupied the northern half of the peninsula. Backed by the Soviets, Kim spent the next five years consolidating his power in North Korea, crushing opposition, including from Christians, and building an army of his own.

society. Those who refused were executed or incarcerated in remote concentration camps where they endured forced labour, and were starved and tortured.

A Vision Revived


In 2011, while praying in the MO prayer room, Eddie Cairns shared two visions the Lord had shown him regarding North Korea. We believe it is timely to share these again now.

The first was a picture of North Korea, then the flag appeared. Suddenly a sword was thrust into it that separated it into two parts. On the second occasion, he

was reading and pondering over his daily reading from 2Samuel 2 & 3 which talks about the period of time following Saul's death.

Samuel had earlier anointed David to become king of Israel, but he was initially only made king of Judah. Saul's reign was constantly opposed to David becoming king, and Ishbosheth was crowned King of Israel. Eddie believed the Holy Spirit was showing him an allegory or picture situation in North Korea.

As strong opposition existed between Saul's dynasty and David's rulership as King of Judah, so too between North and South Korea. We know that God's plan was for David to become king of all Israel, yet the nation remained divided. Saul's kingdom represented the world and flesh, while David's the Spirit and the Lord was with him only. In 2Samuel3:1 it says, '.. That was the beginning of a long war between those who had been loyal to Saul and those who were loyal to David. As time passed, David became stronger while Saul's dynasty became weaker and weaker.' The cruel leadership in North Korea has greatly persecuted God's people there for over a century, and has restricted the spread of the gospel. We know it has not fully succeeded, even as Saul tried to kill David many times, he never had that victory. Surely this vision sheds new light and encouragement and the coming days the Gospel of Christ will grow stronger in this land.



Let's declare that the cruel leadership will grow weaker and weaker and will loose its hold on this nation and that the one star

on the flag, is a sign of Christ's leadership rising up over this people and nation.

Also declare that a watershed moment is coming for this -China's puppet nation - and for its sister nation, South Korea, to become once again a united Korea under the Lordship of Jesus Christ.

Pray for mercy and salvation for Kim Jong Un, and that our Lord and saviour will become his if it is not already too late. Pray God will revive the seeds sown by his great grandmother and repentance will come to the Kim household.

DELIGHTING IN OPPORTUNITIES

What a privilege to head off on a plane with Warren Young and Clive Exelby to Nepal to finish the teaching to pastors and leaders which would complete the 1000 Equipping Centres. Our first conference was in Hetauda which is south of Kathmandu and the second conference was an hours drive out of the eastern city of Dharan (but only 13kms as the crow flies! Those of you that have been to Nepal will be familiar with the state of some of those remote roads).

The official numbers of the two conferences were 118 pastors and leaders trained and 1302 names of those they would in turn train up. Attendees were hungry to hear the word of God and to receive from Him. We taught and ministered on fivefold ministry, baptism in the Holy Spirit, spiritual gifts, and other topics that the Holy Spirit led us into. Men and women were keen to receive from God during the times of impartation.

On our final Saturday in Kathmandu Clive and I had the opportunity to minister in a church in Kathmandu. We gave an opportunity for prayer at the end and many reported "all the pain is gone" or similar. God was moving in healing and prophetic words and we know they were hugely encouraged and blessed. Thankyou Lord!

Praise God we got home safely and before self-isolation measures were required. We're so thankful to God for His timing that the entire trip was finished before the world shut down.
