UNDERSTANDING PAKISTAN

We want to introduce you to the land at the crossroads to Asia, to her history, her people, her culture and her religion. Above all we want to reveal to you what God is doing in Pakistan today, that you may pray, give and maybe go to this land of opportunity.

Pakistan is a young Nation with an ancient history and a rich cultural heritage; it has a history dating back thousands of years before the time of Christ's birth. Some

of the earliest records of settlement are of tribal groups in

the Indus Valley, no doubt benefiting from their proximity to the ancient trade routes like the Silk Road. At this time the Indus Valley was part of India and a stronghold of Buddhism.

But like many Nations around them, they were the subject of many invasions over time, the main ones being Darius of Persia in 500BC, Alexander the great in 328BC, Indo-Greek invasions of 10-2BC which lasted till 7AD when the Arabs and Islam came and set up a Umayyad caliphate over this whole region. The Mongols then invaded the region in time of prosperity but also of great bloodshed, as Islam now dominated nearly all of India.

In the mid-17th century the British Indian Empire was

established bringing to an end the Mughal era, they ruled right up to the mid 19th century. In 1930 poet Allama Mohammad Iqbal presented his dream of a separate homeland for Indian Muslims and in the partition of 1947 through the astute political craftsmanship of Mohammad Ali Jinnah, The Islamic Republic of Pakistan was born.

Originally in two parts East and West Pakistan, East Pakistan separated off in 1971 to become the Independant Bangladesh.

There are 7 provinces in Pakistan with a population of nearly 200 million [2018]. Urdu is the official language but about 40 other languages are spoken as well, and literacy is about 17.9%.

Understanding Pakistan...



Islam is the official religion at 96.6%, of these 90% is Sunni Islam and 10% is Shia Islam. There is 3.4% that are other religions including Christian and Hindu.

Christian preachers have passed through the land known as "the land of the pure", since the 1st century when the Apostle Thomas passed through here on his way to South India. However only after the British conquest of the Sikh Kingdom in Punjab at around 1784 did missions begin intensive evangelistic work in this area.

Right back to the 3rd century there is evidence of Nestorian Christians in northern areas now Pakistan, and Armenian believers who migrated to India from Persia around the 5th century. The evidence of the colonial past can be seen in the many grand church buildings throughout this land.

The result has been that there is a Christian Church today in Pakistan that is numerically strong but spiritually weak. The Church remains essentially evangelical, troubled very little by liberal theology or sectarian false teaching. The problem is ignorance and carnality, not false teaching. In my travels it has been exciting to see the growth of the Charismatic move of God's Holy Spirit, especially in main line denominational Churches. Officially the Government supports freedom of religion, but the reality is many of our brothers and sisters in Christ have suffered persecution and even death at the hands of Muslim extremists. The Muslim community have just come out of the celebration of Eid-Ul-Azha, the end of the annual Hajj and the sacrificing of animals to commemorate Abraham's willingness to sacrifice his son "Ishmael". Pray that they would be open to the revelation of God's love in sending His Son Jesus Christ to be the true sacrifice on behalf of all mankind.

Pray: for the protection of Christians, and that they would be open to the burden of Jesus for fellow country-men, and that they would be bold in their witness. Pray for a powerful move of God's Holy Spirit, signs wonders and miracles.

According to God's Word in Hebrews 13:3, "Continue to remember those in prison as if you were together with them in prison, and those who are mistreated as if you yourselves were suffering." Please remember what the Apostle John saw in Revelation of Jesus chapter 5:9, "And with your blood you purchased for God men from every tribe and language and people and nation," and this includes the people of Pakistan. AMEN.

As the world is gripped by the fear of Covid-19, so it is in Pakistan and Afghanistan. This fear is a lot more in your face than what we are experiencing in NZ, and compounded by the lack of food, basic medical care and infrastructure to distribute emergency aid.

1John 4:18 "There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear. For fear has to do with punishment, and whoever fears has not been perfected in love."

Please pray for our brothers and Sisters in Christ as they seek to be the hands and feet of Jesus to the masses of Covid-19 infected and starving people in their communities. We hear great stories all over Asia of food parcel distribution by some of our co-labourers, but in reality unless the Lord miraculously multiplies these efforts it will not be enough. Pray for miracles of multiplication.

Interestingly in some places the food distribution has led to people opening up to the love of God and some choosing to become followers of Jesus Christ, but in other places this distribution has led to suspicion and violence against our brothers and sisters. Some places in Afghanistan, the locals have blamed the Coronavirus on Christianity. **Pray for their protection.**

In Iran and Afghanistan, the Kingdom of God is advancing at a rapid rate, despite the horrific circumstances that are around them. Matthew 11:12 "From the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven has suffered violence, and the violent take it by force." **Please pray for the Afghan Government**, that they would have wisdom and courage as they face an uncertain future and peace talks with the Taliban on again, then off again.
