With the Lord there is always a way to overcome and He is showing MO new ways to continue to be very effective and


relevant in building God's Kingdom in today's environment when we listen to His voice.

Make a Way to China

As the year 2020 comes to a close, the vast effects of the Coronavirus pandemic across our entire world is hard to comprehend. While many may be praying for an end to this pandemic in order to re-establish a normal life, Christians in China are praying that borders will reopen so that more Bibles can be put in the hands of hungry believers across the nation.

One contact in China said that in early February, China closed its borders, and the Bible courier work came to a sudden stop. For several decades, Bibles have been taken across the borders, more or less on a daily basis, and now suddenly it had completely stopped!

Fortunately, there were some Bibles in a storeroom in China, so they were sent out quickly to the contacts who had been waiting for their copies of the precious Book.

In the weeks leading up to the Corona-situation, several contacts in China pleaded that they were all desperate to get Bibles. Churches were growing, but they suffered due to the fact that they were not able to provide the God's Word to the new believers!

Another contact also sent several messages requesting Bibles. He is leading a network of 18,000 churches, and is training 6,000 pastors in church-planting. He also asked when I would be coming back to China again. I had to tell him that the border is closed, so we cannot come. He pleaded with me several times and said they needed Bibles more than ever,. He wrote; "Dear, dear brother, can you at least get me 100 copies? Please, please!"

It is heart breaking to hear about the desperate need of the Chinese believers for the Word of God, and not to be able to help right now. But, we are preparing and waiting for the Lord to open the borders to this enormous nation. Let's pray together with one heart, that God will make some way so that we can get the Bibles to them.

CHINA

1 Pray that borders would open so that Bibles can be distributed to the many hungry hearts waiting for the Word.

2 Pray for the Uyghur people of Xinjiang who are increasingly oppressed by the Chinese government in restricting of their cultural and religious freedoms. As Gospel work in Xinjiang has been curtailed, pray for pioneers to take the gospel to the Uyghurs and that Uyghur believers be strengthened and protected. (Frontiers)

<u>USA</u>

3 Pray for Donald Trump who requested prayer of Christians for a case that was taken to the Supreme Court on 11th November 2020. Ask the Lord for favour and to expose everything that needs to be uncovered and for righteousness and truth to win out.

INDIA

4 Pray against corruption of the government, that they would lay down pride and embrace truth and righteousness. Pray against the exploitation of the poor and weak that they instead would be cared for. Pray for an end to the caste system, that every person would know the value and dignity of themselves and each other.

5 & 6 Pray for those with leprosy who carry the pain of rejection, deformity, atrocious living conditions and hopelessness. Pray that through the pastors who minister to them that they would be restored in the love of Christ, in hope and in dignity.

7 With travel being restricted, pray that those ministering to the needy would find ways and strategies to reach those needing help and hope.

PAKISTAN

8 Please pray for a 13 year old girl who is being hunted by Islamic people for converting to Christ. Praise God she is in a shelter while waiting for her court hearing. Pray also for justice for her and others like her that this type of thing will cease.

UGANDA

10 Pray for Pastor John other Pastors as they go door to door sharing the power of the Gospel. May they be anointed by the Holy Spirit to see people healed, delivered and saved. Praise God for those who have been saved, and may they be established in the Word and Spirit.

11 Pray for the many who have experienced sexual abuse. May they be released through Jesus from brokenness and severe loss. Pray for the grace to forgive their perpetrators.

NEPAL

12 & 13 Praise God for newly translated book "Awesome Power of Blessing" of which 10000 copies have been printed for Body Builders Equipping Centres. Pray for funds for another 20000 copies. Pray for youth who will attend a seminar being taught from this book, and for 25 more Blessing seminars next year.

14 Continue to pray for the release of the printing press through the borders from India to Nepal so that it can be put to work in order to distribute Bibles and teaching materials.

PERSECUTED CHURCH

15 Pray for believers who are suffering for the gospel that they be strengthened and encouraged in their faith. Pray for grace and provision for families of Christians in prison. Pray that those in prison may reach their inmates with the hope of Christ. Pray for God's sovereign hand on Christian families under persecution.

NORTH KOREA

16 UN sanctions are causing severe hardship in food supplies and healthcare provision. Pray for improved international relationships that would lead to greater provision for all the people living in North Korea. (BMS World Mission)

SOUTHEAST ASIA

18 Pray for those affected by heavy rain and flooding in Cambodia, Laos, Thailand and Vietnam last October, including families of the 28 who died in the disaster. Pray for provision for basic needs of shelter, food and income as many crops were destroyed. Strengthen church networks to reach out with faith and the practical gospel. (EA)

LAOS

19 & 20 Pray that Christians stand as a strong witness of Christ amidst continued persecution despite the new law that gives Christians the freedom to exercise their faith. Pray for strength and safety for the Church leaders as they coordinate with the central government to communicate about the new law to the authorities in rural areas. Pray that it will be well received. (EA)

CAMBODIA

21 Cambodian families are facing crippling debt from finance schemes gone wrong, and loss of their land and livelihood. Pray for wisdom, supernatural strategies for Christian families to become free of debt and prevent land from being permanently sold out of the tribal communities. May they lead the way for others and bring restoration to their communities.

December 2020

22 Many local farmers and communities have lost their land to rich and powerful investors. Pray for God's wisdom and power to be revealed in reversing the injustices.

23 Pray that God's people would be strengthened to be fully devoted to the Lord, to "love not their own lives" and to rise up as Kingdom agents for cultural, economic and livelihood transformation of their communities.

MYANMAR

24 Pray for resolution to the world's longest running civil conflict. Decades long ethnic tensions continue to run high, especially among the majority Burmese army and minority peoples. Pray for peace and justice in this significant year of national elections. (LMI)

CHRISTMAS DAY

25 Pray that Jesus Christ be exalted accross the earth this day as our precious gift of hope and salvation. Pray that the gospel would reach far and wide this day.

VIETNAM

26 & 27 Pray for 120000 families whose houses have been damaged in the October floods. Pray for 93 families of those who died in the disaster. Pray for provision, health and hope. (EA)

28 Pray that Christians in Vietnam will know God's peace and presence amidst government control of religious activity. Despite some improvement in religious freedom in Vietnam in recent years, some believers continue to face intense pressure, especially those who speak out against corruption and rights abuses. (RI)

IRAN

29 Converts to Christianity commonly face ill-treatment and injustice. Please pray the Iranian authorities will respect the human right to freedom of religion and will cease targeting Christian gatherings and criminalising the peaceful activities of converts. Please pray Christians across Iran will be strengthened by God's love and enjoy liberty to gather in worship and fellowship. (MEC)

NZ

30 Pray for continued discernment of God's voice for the MO Board as they make decisions for the new year.

31 Pray for an awakening and boldness on believers to share their faith. Pray for willingness to go and minister to the lost, despite rejection. Ask for an increase of anointing, miracles and words of knowledge. Pray against fear of man.
