Breath of Life - Urgent Appeal

“Two days ago I was with my wife begging for help in front of the hospital.” Such is the cry of one man in Nepal and most likely many others in countries like Pakistan and India, where the existing healthcare system (if any) cannot cope with the onslaught of another wave of COVID-19. The latest wave has resulted in many infected people being left to die because of insufficient hospital beds, oxygen and other medical supplies.

The man continued with his story: “The people from the hospital came, gave her oxygen and took her inside. I haven’t been able to see her since then, so I don’t know how she is. I hope she is doing well. Every time I ask the doctor about her condition, he nods his head and assures me that she will be fine.

My wife said that it's getting harder for her to breathe every moment so when I asked the doctor about her again, he told me that there isn't any oxygen cylinders left in the hospital. He asked me instead to go and find one myself for my wife.

I feel hopeless, if only I could share my breath with her and make things easier, but that's impossible and I am helpless in this situation. I don't know anyone who distributes or sells oxygen, I don't know whom to reach out to nor can I do anything during this time. I hope she will be alright, and that she will make it fine.

After she comes out of the hospital I am hoping to take her to visit the newly built Dharahara (the historic landmark that was demolished by the 2015 earthquake) as she has wanted to go and see it for a very long time now.



The government has renovated many historic landmarks and made them so beautiful they are worth looking at, but if only they could have worked on building better hospitals as well it really would have prevented things from being this difficult for the people now.

I have asked a few of my friends to look for an oxygen cylinder so we will see. All I see these days is everybody panicking, everybody worried and everybody infected and struggling with their life.

If only our government and politicians could see what I am seeing, maybe things would be different. Even so, I have not given up hope that things will be good again.”

So, regardless of the hundreds being admitted to hospitals every day in Nepal, Pakistan and other nations, many people are still not receiving the medical care they need, they and their families are suffering miserably, and the death rate continues to increase.

The need is urgent and MO believes it is important to meet the needs of the people. It is also an opportunity to share the gospel as our love and care opens doors.

MO would like to support our contacts in Nepal and Pakistan by helping to fund the purchase of oxygen, cylinders, gloves, masks etc. In Nepal, some cylinders will go to each hospital, medical clinics and some will be given to patients recovering at home. The cylinders will be refilled and redistributed where needed. There is also a need for tents in Nepal, so that those with COVID can have shelter and be isolated as they recover. The appeal will also help purchase medical supplies such as masks, hand sanitisers and gloves to prevent further spread of the virus.

Muslim World

It has been an answer to prayer that since the completion of Ramadan this year, there have been many reports from Muslim nations of those who have had divine encounters with Jesus in dreams and visions. Then many are seeking out Christians to help them understand these encounters.

So many people in Afghanistan are gripped by constant fear with the rapid spread of COVID-19 in their nation, in addition to the threat of violence and death from the increased presence of ISIS and Taliban terrorists. It has been recently reported that many villagers have been turning up at the doors of believers homes, seeking comfort and guidance. Glory to God that in a number of villages people are asking the 'Prince of Peace' to come into their lives as Saviour and Lord. In one place there were 14 souls saved.

In Pakistan a pastor was told to go to a specific area and house to start a church but was shot by 3 Muslim men. So God sent another pastor to that same house. This pastor was captured and taken to stand before 600 hooded men.

The men proceeded to take off their hoods and humbly asked the pastor to pray for them! Every one of them had seen Jesus in a vision who told them they have blood on their hands. All 600 men repented before the Lord that night!

Praise God that His Holy Spirit guides His people, and they hearken to His voice and become a beacon of light and hope to the fearful and the lost.

India

Idols, once objects of hope and salvation, have been thrown into the dump to be pushed around by bulldozers, as many people have realised they cannot save them from COVID. GLOBAL

1 Pray that Coronavirus be broken off the nations in Jesus Name. Pray for an increase of faith, hope and love to displace fear and despair. Declare repentance over the nations, that healing would come to the lands.

2 Pray that in place of devastation there would be revival.

3 & 4 Pray for miracle multiplication on Holy Spirit endeavours. Declare that the move of Holy Spirit would overtake any spread of coronavirus. Pray that where Christianity is forbidden, it would not be stopped but rather those in hiding would be ignited by Holy Spirit in his power and love.

5 Pray for pastors and shepherds of the Church across the world for divine wisdom and sensitivity to Holy Spirit to lead and equip God's people. Pray the blood of Jesus to cover them and their families. Pray for a new realm of glory over the pastors, that COVID would die in any place they approach.

6 Declare God is Provider for every need. Pray people be anchored in God's goodness so they are strong in every storm.

NEPAL

7 Praise God for families coming to Jesus through gifts of rice. Pray for new believers to be established in faith, the Spirit and the Word.

8 Pray for provision to be miraculously multiplied quickly for the needy of Nepal, whether it be provision of food, medical supplies or grace, peace and healing to those suffering. Praise God that He is the source of all good things, and he is the God of restoration.

9 Pray for the pastors of Nepal including Pastor Samuel and his wife Mangali, and Pastor Bishnu traveling by motorbike, for dynamic faith, anointing and miracles as they minister across the nation. Pray for provision and distribution of gospel tracts.

CHINA

10 & 11 Pray for believers and church leaders in prison, that their faith would displace any discouragement, and that their influence would increase so that God would be even more glorified through them.

12 Agree with God for good fruit to be produced wherever the Word is sown.

13 Pray for a covering of truth over children of Christians in prison who are at risk of being brainwashed against their parents. Pray for divine revelation that these children would be established in the truth of Christ. Pray that the mouths of the deceivers would be silenced.

INDIA

14 Pray for the healing and recovery of a pastor's wife who was abducted and sold to a brothel where she was kept for about a month before police rescued her and reunited her with her family. Pray for covering over church leaders and their families, and that Jesus would be glorified in all circumstances.

15 Pray for a strong Hindu community where a young pastor has died of Covid. Pray that even his death would be a witness for Jesus in that community. Pray for support and love for his wife.

16 Pray that all those who have lost hope in their idols who can't save them from COVID, would not be lost but find their anchor in Jesus Christ, and be found in His love and Peace.

ISRAEL

17 & 18 The 17th July corresponds to 9th of the month of Av in the Jewish calendar where Jews observe the fast of Tishah B'Av to mourn for the condemnation of the generation of Israel to die before entering the promised land (Numbers 14). Fear overtook their faith in God. Repent for lack of faith in God and ask Him for the gift of faith to see His works accomplished in the earth. Pray for a generation of faith to rise up to walk in all God's purposes for His glory in the earth.

19 Pray for peace in Israel. Pray that as the people of Israel recognise Jesus as their Redeemer who has great compassion on them, that every weapon formed against them would not prosper.

MUSLIMS

20 Today is Eid ul Adha, a festival held by Muslims to celebrate Abraham's willingness to sacrifice his son Ishmael (Bible recounts it was Isaac), which greatly pleased Allah. Pray for a revelation of the sacrifice God made in His Son Jesus and all that has been accomplished by His blood. Ask God to increase faith that His people may willingly lay down all they may call precious for the sake of trusting God and walking in radical obedience.

HINDUS

21 On this day Hindus, particularly married women, observe various rituals of Jaya Parvati Vrat believing that doing this will ensure blessing to their marriage and family. This is done in remembrance of a certain woman who did the same in order to get back her husband's life. Today, declare a blessing over women that they would know their created worth and value in God's eyes, and that they would know the fear of the Lord which is worthy of praise.

SEIKHS

22 Yesterday was also Miri Piri Day for those who follow the Sikh religion. The 6th Sikh guru carried two swords, one symbolising temporal authority (Miri), and the other

symbolising spiritual authority (Piri) based on a vision he had of these things. Today let us give praise to Jesus the giver of all authority and influence. Pray that Christians would stand in their authority and led by Holy Spirit in becoming influential for the Kingdom.

IRAN

23 Pray for wisdom, boldness and endurance for Christians as an amendment to the law has tightened religious freedom where it has become an offense to talk about anything in conflict with Islamic values and teaching. Pray Christians would not be swayed but be established in the Word of God.

BUDDHISTS

24 & 25 On 24th July Buddhists celebrate Buddha preaching his first discourse after his enlightenment. Pray those listening realise he is not a god, and to seek the one true god. Praise God that He freely gives the Holy Spirit to bring understanding of the Word of God. Declare a revelation of Jesus to all who practice Buddhism.

AFGHANISTAN

26 Pray that leaders would take courage to walk in righteousness and unity and receive the wisdom of God. Pray that in weakness the Lord would be strong.

27 Praise God for answers to prayer for revelation of Jesus and for the humility of those seeking help from Christians. May they find all the fullness of Christ to fill their thirsty hearts, and also become beacons of hope to others. Thank God for what He is doing and pray that he brings His work to completion, that a harvest of millions would come from this nation, that Jesus would be Prince of Peace in Afghanistan.

MYANMAR

28 Pray as the People's Defense Force rises against the military that reconciliation and peace would be the result, and that the nation would be governed in righteousness. Pray for the civil war to cease.

29 Pray for pastors in the discipling of young believers. Pray for believers to represent Jesus well in these complex circumstances. Pray for a deeper anchoring in Jesus.

NZ

30 Pray for a blessing and anointing on prison ministry, that atmospheres will shift when God's people walk in. Pray that those in prison would find freedom in the forgiveness and love of God. Pray for miracles, deliverance and transformation from the inside out.

31 Pray for the undertaking of Eddie's book reprinting. Pray God would prepare hearts to receive Eddie's testimony and be ignited for radical obedience.
