Matthew 1:21 declares "And she will bring forth a Son and you shall call His name Jesus for He will save His people from their sins." On that glorious night in Bethlehem when our Saviour Jesus was born, the world changed forever!

John 1: 9 speaks of Jesus as the True Light, "The True Light that gives light to all was coming into the world," and John 1:14, as The Word, "And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us and we beheld His glory, the glory as the only begotten of the Father full of grace and truth." Jesus is the true Light and Word and makes a way for those He loves.

The Christmas season is a time to remember Jesus birth and give thanks for Him and to Him for coming to earth that we and all mankind can be saved and reconciled to the Father. We thank Him for all He has done for each one of us, as He is the greatest gift we could ever receive.

December is a time to reflect on what God has done throughout the year. We have seen His faithfulness in helping to build His Kingdom in various ways, in nine nations. Coronavirus cannot go without a mention as projects were in response to the huge needs of our brethren and the lost as a result of it. Our main responses were funding 'Food for the Hungry' in four nations and provision of medical supplies in two. These created opportunities to sow the seed of the gospel and opened the doors of many hearts to the love of Jesus. Thousands of gospel tracts were given out and many souls were saved.

Throughout the year, we maintained our focus on the provision of Bibles for six countries and although hindered by C19 for a time, pastor and leader bible training and women's sewing training continued in limited numbers as soon as lockdowns were lifted.

One of our largest projects to be completed this year was the printing press in Nepal. We are so thankful that despite

the many hindrances and delays, this is now operational with Richard Brunton's "Awesome Power of Blessing" book and Geoff Woodcock's "First Love" book both translated into Nepali, being first off the press along with Gospel Tracts which are an important tool for sharing about Jesus.

We had an extraordinary response for Eddie's book reprint "To Catch the Wind" and hope to print it in early 2022.

We praise the Lord that He continued to open new doors for strategic partnerships and for the growth in financial giving which so far, is up by nearly 25%. This means we are helping and empowering more people to grow the Kingdom of God, which is why MO exists. MO has no paid staff and all board members are volunteers. Administration expenses are minimal with the main cost being printing and distribution of the monthly newsletter. This means that most of our income can be used directly for the work of the Kingdom.

God has done over abundantly above all that we could ask or think! All glory and thanks for His provision and many answered prayers! We are very encouraged by your love and support of MO and those we serve overseas, as we could not do anything without your help. The MO Board would like to thank you for your Love and support during 2021 and pray you all have a wonderful and blessed Christmas with your family and friends.

CURRENT PROJECTS

Ministry to Outcasts, Pakistan (NEW)

The ministry to the outcasts of Pakistan started when this desperate need was discovered during aid distribution in

the Covid-19 lockdown in Pakistan last year. Since then many lives have been transformed by the unconditional love of Christ. They have many needs: A shelter home for recovery and education, 5 Laptops, desks & chairs

for computer skills training, food, medical treatment, bikes for transport and employment.

Please help us bless these souls and show our love to them also.

Total Project: \$10,000 Balance needed: \$6,000

DISASTER RELIEF: Flood & Refugee Victims (NEW)

Massive floods and landslides swept through parts of

West Nepal in October so our response teams have provided blankets and food for those affected. Your help with this would be greatly appreciated.





Nepal Medical Supplies Appeal: (COMPLETED!)

We are delighted to report that this project has been completed. Thousands of people have been helped with the provision of sanitizer, masks, oxygen etc and the waves of Covid have slowed down considerably with the country returning to a new level of normal especially in rural areas. Thank you for your generous giving, prayers and support of this appeal.

FEED THE HUNGRY - COMPLETED!

The poor are the ones that suffered the most during Covid19, but our understanding is that for Nepal anyway life has returned to a new normal and the people are able to function again to some degree. Thank you for helping feed many 1000's of people this year! This opened doors to share the gospel in many areas and souls were saved and ongoing support is being offered through some of our other projects such as the Outcasts Ministry and our new Flood and Refugee Victims Project.

Bibles for China

In honour and memory of the 40 years since Project Pearl, we wish to fund more Chinese bibles as their need for the Word of God is so great. MO committed to raise funds for least 6000 bibles at a cost of approx. \$3.00

Prayer Calendar

GLOBAL CHURCH

1 In this time when the enemy seeks to divide, pray for the supernatural unity of the Church. Pray for wisdom and sensitivity for leaders to minister to the Body. Pray for great grace for each other and great peace.

2 Pray for a clearing of the "fog" of confusion over God's peoples' minds, that we would hear the Shepherd's voice clearly and know the task he has prepared in advance for us to do. That we would be sharp and effective for the increase of the Kingdom.

3 Pray that those who risk their lives daily by believing in Jesus would serve to inspire boldness in believers with religious freedom. Pray that the power of expressing forgiveness to "enemies", like many martyrs, would sweep across the earth bringing many to Christ.

4 & 5 Pray for comfort and provision for widows and families of those martyred. Pray for churches of pastors who have been martyred to receive the support they need.

GLOBAL

6 Pray that God would speak to people in their confinement and stress and that His peace would prevail over every household. Pray that people would reach out to God and to believers. Declare faith to overtake all fear. Declare the Body be messengers of authentic hope and peace and joy to the world.

7 Pray that the youth would rise up unshackled and unhindered in the strength of the Lord. In place of torment, speak inheritance in Christ. Break off spiritual blindness and pray alertness and zeal in the purposes of God to walk in them.

KORFA

8 Pray that the Sword of the Spirit, the Word of God would be the victorious weapon of the nation.

Pray for grace and mercy, unity and peace to flow like a river. Declare the Lord Jesus as the Redeemer of Korea.

<u>INDIA</u>

9 Praise God for an 87 year old pastor who remains passionate to share the gospel to unreached people everywhere. Pray for increase of healing anointing and fruitfulness to his ministry.

10 Pray for God's covering and blessing over the baptisms of believers.

11 & 12 Pray for several Christian families in Odisha state who have either been subject to violence for their faith, denied water, had their homes torched or been ostracised from their own villages. This is common treatment of Christians. Pray for strength, miraculous provision and forgiveness toward their persecutors.

AFGHANISTAN

13 Declare the light of the gospel to come to this nation, the lost be brought to salvation.

14 Speak mercy and grace over all people as they face starvation, the terror of beheading and the near economic collapse of the nation. Declare a supernatural upholding of the Lord, for miracles of provision and peace.

15 Pray for women and girls in Afghanistan at risk of being abducted for marriage to Islamist Taliban Fighters. Pray for a covering of protection over them, that they would be hidden and kept from this evil.

NEPAL

16 Landslides and floods due to unseasonal rain in October have devastated 20 districts, resulting in 104 deaths and 26 missing, damage to housing, crops and highways being blocked. Pray for comfort, refuge and God's provision and restoration.

MYANMAR

17 Pray for hope to arise in the hearts of people, especially leaders, despite many deaths to Covid. Give the leaders a divine enabling to humbly seek and inquire of the Lord, in order to lead the Church for such a harvest time as this. Let those who would turn to the arm of the flesh turn rather to the Lord that He would undertake and bring the victory. Let the testimonies of God's goodness and provision bring many more to faith and trust in Him.

PAKISTAN

18 & 19 Pray for protection and anointing on the labourers to the outcasts, that God would breathe His Holy Spirit into these precious people to revive and restore them in dignity. Declare God's purpose and plan over their lives. Pray for provision of income, food, and special care needs.

20 Pray for a covering on Bible transport and distribution in this nation.

21 Pray for those locked up that their spirits would be free in salvation.

CHINA

22 Praise God for a street evangelist who after his 6th imprisonment and release this year, is once again excited to get back on the street to preach the gospel. Pray for continued grace and God's presence on him. Pray for signs and wonders to accompany his ministry and that many would be impacted by his zeal.

23 Pray that as certain Bible and Quran apps are removed from availability to those in China, this would cause even more interest in the Word of God, and other ways of access to the Word would become more available. Pray for wisdom and covering for all Bible distribution strategies.

CHRISTMAS EVE

24 Praise God for our most precious gift, Jesus, the Hope of every weary soul, the True Light for every unknown, to make a Way where there is no way, and bring new vision. Pray for revelations of Jesus across the world.

CHRISTMAS DAY

25 & 26 Praise God for Hope in Jesus, for restoration to the Father and a new start. Pray for God's forgiveness to be experienced across the world, for the joy of the love of the Father, and for reconciliation of families and nations.

UGANDA

27 Pray for God's anointing on organised outreaches. Pray that children and youth would come to Christ and that new believers would quickly mature in their faith and ignite their nation and beyond with the gospel. Pray for raising up of more leaders and elders for the churches.

28 Break off all division from the Church and pray for humility, forgiveness and unity. Praise God for the supernatural work that only He can do amongst us.
