God of Increase

"I have not heard such teaching before," said a young pastor who had approached me after a teaching session. I could see from the joy in the eyes of the others that what this young man had just said to me was true for the rest of them too. This was the first time they had received teaching on the power of blessing, the five-fold ministry and First Love... and they were hungry for more.

These church leaders had committed themselves to make disciples. Sitting under the teaching, training and equipping at the Body Builders for Christ (BBC) conferences would give them the tools and material to teach and impart to young believers over the coming year.

Each leader at the conference would receive 7 books which had been taught from in the conference and that they could then go on to use for teaching each disciple.

God was revealing Himself to these leaders in new ways. They were not only being taught, they were being filled with the power and love of the Father, and many got baptised in the Holy Spirit. They were being equipped for the work of the Kingdom.

With great joy and excitement the MO team from NZ and USA resumed the BBC conferences in October this year that had been postponed due to travel restrictions. At the completion of the 3 conferences, we have a total of 1,131 Nepalese churches involved in teaching, training and imparting Holy Spirit to 17,033 more believers.



Our God is a God of increase. Jesus calls us to go and make disciples of all men, and this God given strategy is about increasing His Kingdom in hearts and nations with the Gospel of Jesus, the Way of salvation, and letting the Truth of the Word do His transforming work.

Christmas Outreach Crusades

In December this year MO is supporting a Christmas Outreach Crusade in Nepal. This will be hosted by various Nepalese churches, and church members are asked to bring a least one non-Christian to the meetings where Ps. Samuel Rai will share the Gospel. We are believing for 5 to 8 thousand people to attend these crusades and MO has committed to supply 5000 New Testaments with Psalms, Proverbs and 190 commonly asked questions and scriptural answers about faith in Jesus.

Building the Body of Christ

Jesus said our fruitfulness is the measure of our discipleship (John 15:8), that is, our abiding and following Jesus will bring about fruitfulness and increase. As we partnered with our Lord and served the Body of Christ in Nepal through the BBC conferences, we saw the impact of the Word of God in hearts through prayer, encouragement, equipping, and training. We saw Christ building His church in Nepal!

Three internal flights, 26 hours of road travel over 800kms to the 3 conference locations, landslide and boggy padi fields, delays were nothing compared to the treasure of God's people – each one with their own story, journey, and destiny. Our team of nine was privileged to be part of God's work in these people, in praying, interacting, serving, and equipping them.

The team was greatly impacted by the experience. Each member operated in their unique giftings, and we got to see God multiply our efforts for His glory.

I can never be the same having now met the people of Nepal. My heart was so touched by their warm friendliness and I am inspired by all they have overcome.

Myself and 3 other women said 'yes' to being part of the team to Nepal. Though we were very different in age and experience, we all knew God had called us to go and to bring the love of God to the beautiful women of Nepal. Naomi, a Japanese lady on her first mission trip, Keziah a keen 18 year old from NZ, Debbie a NZ school teacher who had previously taught in Kathmandu, and myself.

It was a real joy for me to see the team being used in unique ways through teaching, testimonies, praying for the ladies, and interacting with the children.

We saw God move each time we taught on the baptism in the Holy Spirit and invited the ladies to come forward and receive. Immediately they all burst into tongues and the interpreter reassured us this was not their own language.

When we visited with the 300 children of Emmanuel School in Pokhara, the children were particularly excited to learn origami with Naomi!

This visit to Nepal will stay with me not only because it

was my first trip there, but because of how the gentleness of the people touched my heart.

We were given the privilege to answer his questions and lead him closer to Jesus! We rejoice that where one sows, another reaps but it is God who brings the increase. Hallelujah!

New Testaments with Q&A for Nepal



PEARL 22
