SOWING GOSPEL SEEDS

As many people around the world made preparations for Christmas celebrations with family and friends in December last year, in Nepal the message of Christ was going forth to thousands of people with much celebration, and thousands of New Testaments were given out. Government leaders promised to establish Christmas day as a public holiday and publicly acknowledged Christian values.

In the six days before Christmas, a series of four Christmas gospel crusades were held in various locations across the nation: Kerabari in Bhogateni, Chaudandigadi in Udaypur, Rapti in Chitwan and

Pokhara city. Local churches joined together to organise and serve with songs and cultural dances for the crusades.

Special guests included Mayors, Deputy Mayors, MPs, members of Christian societies, newspaper and radio reporters, and other respected people.

After one of the local pastors opened the crusade in prayer, the Christians gathered

together to walk around the area with banners and musical instruments, giving an invitation for all to come.

From 1000 to 7500 people attended each crusade, with about 40% of them being unbelievers. People walked, motorcycled and bused to the crusades. For two of the crusades, ten extra buses were provided in addition to the usual city buses.

The key speaker was Rev Dr Samuel Rai, who we work

Samuel Rai, who we work with and know as Pastor Samuel, shared the message of the Christmas celebration, Jesus birth as saviour of the world. He also spoke on justice, peace, equality and freedom. He explained that in Christianity there is no discrimination on the basis of caste, gender, religion, colour, profession or

personality. The government continues to discriminate against Christians on the basis of faith, so Samuel enouraged the people to take hold of their rights as Nepali citizens, but more importantly as children of God.

He spoke of the Christians' love for God and compassion for people, and gave an invitation to believe in the Lord Jesus Christ and become a child of God (John 1:12).

Seeds of the gospel were sown and thousands of New Testaments were given out during the course of the crusades. So far 350 new believers have turned to Jesus. The churches involved in each area are continuing to follow up those who attended and Samuel is believing that about 1000 will eventually make a commitment to Jesus.

It was significant to have government leaders publicly honour God. The Mayor of Kerabari declared Christmas day to now be a public holiday, and also decided that local government will take steps for the management and protection of Christian churches. The Deputy Mayor also acknowledged that the Christian faith emphasises the importance of relationships, sharing and helping those in need.

In Chadandigadi, The Assembly member of State No.1 shared his commitment to fight for religious freedom, and support the religious right of Christians.

As part of Pearl 22, 3000 New Testaments with Questions & Answers were printed by GTN and 5000 New Testaments purchased from the Bible Society for Nepal most of which were given out during the crusades.

Samuel is so thankful for the generous provision of New Testaments to feed and sustain hungry souls in Nepal.

Please pray for those who attended the crusades that the words they heard, will continue to impact them and draw them to Jesus as their Lord and Saviour. Pray also that promises to work towards equity and religious freedom for Christians will be honoured.

THE POWER OF LOVE



In the very poor and remote village of Buyenda in Uganda, as the light of the new year dawned, many also received the light of truth for their hungry souls – their very own Bible!

These ones are those who said nearly 6 months ago 'yes Pastor John, I would really love a Bible of my own'. There was such joy on the faces of those who own so little to be given a gift of the precious Word of God in their own language. In reading and meditating on God's Word, they now have opportunity to become rich in spirit, strong in faith,

and know the treasures of Heaven. Glory to God!

One such treasure of heaven was a 60 year old Muslim man (pictured) who went to his mosque with a certain problem. No one at the mosque gave him care, help or a Quran. He then met some Christians who showed him love and gave him a Bible. He was so touched that he became a follower of Jesus and so did seven of his Muslim friends! The power of love!

PEARL 22

- 6 Praise God for Samuel's 'nation changer' anointing. Pray for continued boldness and wisdom as he speaks with authorities in various regions. Pray for the salvation of Hindu antagonists and bind their hindrances to the gospel.

7 Praise God for Bibles received in Buyenda village. Pray that Holy Spirit quicken the Word to them as they read and meditate on it. Pray for Holy Spirit fire to ignite in their spirits and move them to compassionate obedience.

TURKEY & SYRIA

CAMBODIA

- **10** Give glory to God that at the recent Cambodia Gospel Centennial Celebration, Prime Minister Hun Sen acknowledged the positive impact of the Christian community on the nation.
- 11 & 12 Pray that the church would arise in wholeness and in calling to five fold ministries. Pray for the raising up of young people to serve God in various

VIETNAM

13 As the Communist Party makes stricter laws about 'misinformation' on social media platforms, pray that churches would use wisdom on social media. Pray also that this would serve to fuel the curiosity of the lost to find the truth in Jesus.

PERSECUTED CHURCH

14 Praise God that He is the God of the impossible. Take up the weapon of praise. Declare the 'impossible' be made possible. Pray for grace and strength to those suffering, that their inner reality would overcome their outward situation. Invite God's transformation.

- **15** For those in prison camps especially in North Korea and China, pray for healing to their physical and emotional wounds, and blessing to their families. Declare God is their Way Maker and supplier of grace and mercy. Pray that their needs would be met, and that harassment would stop.
- **16** For those in solitary confinement, pray that they would continue to stand for Christ. Pray for a sound mind as promised (2 Tim. 1:7), and their faith and courage will increase. Pray that every attack against the Kingdom of God would come to nothing.

NORTH KOREA

- 17 Praise God that despite being the worst country for Christian persecution for 20 years, an estimated 300,000 Christians still worship in secret. Pray for their continued courage, faith, strength, wisdom and
- 18 & 19 Pray the witness of believers will impact the nation, which for all its 'power' cannot shake their faith. Pray that the strength of the nation would be acknowledged as the faith of those following Christ, and ultimately that Christwill reign victorious there..

20 Recently was the 2nd anniversary of the 2021 coup that overthrew the democratically elected government. Pray for a turning of hearts of the military to see that violence is futile. Pray for justice, peace and stability. Give thanks for the many turning to Jesus in this nation and for the successful delivery of bibles to these new believers.

GLOBAL 21 Praise God that He is drawing people together. Pray for an awakening to the truth and love of Jesus and that only He can still the storms in life. Pray for a revelation of eternal priorities and for believers to

reach out to their friends with the Love of Christ.

PAKISTAN

22 Continue to pray for God's divinely selected team to accompany Clive on the October trip. Pray for God's sovereign hand on all the preparations, and that the steps of the team will be ordered by the Lord.
