Desperate for God's Word

With a population of 190,000 people, for countless centuries the Koho have inhabited villages nestled in the beautiful mountains of south-central Vietnam, with the majority in Lam Dong Province.

For many generations the Koho people have been animists, worshipping numerous deities, including the sun, moon, prominent mountains, rivers and large trees.

Memories of an Ancient God

Despite their separation from the one true God, He graciously did not forget the Koho people.

Although they did not have a written language until recently, many legends similar to accounts in the book of Genesis have been retained by the Koho and passed down through songs and poems to each new generation. Some of the Koho legends include an account of a worldwide flood.

From the late 1800s and early 1900s, Catholicism impacted this tribe especially those living in the towns. In the remote villages, however, their ancient, traditional beliefs were not replaced but combined with Catholicism to create a toxic syncretic religion "having a form of godliness but denying its power" (2 Timothy 3:5).

Evangelical missionaries only commenced work among the Koho in the 1940s more than half a century after the

Catholics. They soon found many fertile hearts eager for the Gospel, and thousands of Koho repented of their sins, denounced their spirit worship and idolatry, and embraced the Lord Jesus Christ.

The Koho believers were desperate for Bibles in their own language, as most of them struggle to understand Vietnamese. When the Koho New Testament was finally published in 1967, having God's Word in their own language made an immediate and powerful impact on Koho society.

By 1998, there were 57,000 believers, almost half of the population at that time. During that year, Asia Harvest printed and delivered their first Koho Bibles, even though they were viewed as contraband by the Communist government in Vietnam.

The years have rolled on and the Koho church continues to walk with God.

The number of new Koho Bibles has dwindled since 2009, falling far behind the need. It does not help that the Koho Bible is not available in Vietnam, and printing it is considered illegal. So God has had to give new strategies to enable the supply of this highly desired book.

Late last year Koho church leaders expressed their urgent need for more Bibles, having been largely starved of God's Word for two decades.

Work was immediately started to meet their request and recently the printing and delivery of 20,000 full Koho Bibles was completed!

While we cannot share too many details for security reasons, the photo on the left is of some of the bibles before they made their way to the Koho villages, where thousands of believers have given thanks to God for remembering them and their need for Bibles.

The need is so great, many more bibles are required to feed these hungry believers. As part of Pearl 22 we would like to help supply more bibles for the Koho Tribe of Vietnam.

Turkey Receives the Word with Joy!

It is time for Turkey to know a Loving Heavenly Father by Name! Funds from MO have enabled our partners in Turkey to translate Bibles into Turkish. This is really important for Turkey because previous translations have been in Arabic, which translates God as Allah.

Our mission partners Michael and Natasha have been reaching the unreached with the message of the gospel for two decades, across 40 countries, primarily by ushering in the Presence of God through music. They have recently begun humanitarian work in Turkey particularly since the earthquake of February 2023.

As their family have traveled and ministered throughout the country, they now have a new opportunity, thanks to supporters of MO, to reach people with the bread of the Word of God. Whether at church meetings or connecting with someone at a gas station, people are overjoyed to receive the gift of a bible.

Michael recalls these testimonies from their travels through Turkey:

"On one particular occasion after Natasha shared a message at a meeting and called people to faith, 12 people accepted the Lord and were able to receive their very own New Testament thanks to MO.

Whenever we are at a fuel station to fill up our vehicle, we enjoy talking with people there. During our conversations, we ask them if they enjoy reading. One time we asked a girl, who replied that she liked reading very much. So we told her if she would like to read a bible we can give it to her. She was delighted to receive it!

On a road trip through Turkey, we stopped at another fuel station to stretch our legs, and fill up the car. However, there was actually no fuel at the gas station, instead we had a divine meeting with a young man there. We were blessed with the opportunity to chat with him about the God of the Bible and asked if he wanted one we could give it to him. He said that his father was an Imam (Islamic leader) and that he had taken them to church when they were in Austria, and so he welcomed the Word of God with joy!

Thanks again to MO for including us as part of Project Pearl 22 so we can reach the unreached with the gospel and the Word of God."

We praise God that a shaken nation can now begin to

build their lives on the Rock through the gift of Turkish New Testaments. This was a part of MO's Pearl 22 which has enabled the provision of 11,000 for this nation.

Koho Bibles, Vietnam (New)

We are very blessed to have the opportunity to help provide more bibles for the Vietnamese Koho tribe. They are a people hungry for God's Word. God has given His strategies for enabling the printing and delivery of these bibles which we are honoured to be able to help with. Please prayerfully consider helping us with this new project. Audio Bibles for Pakistan (New)

We have been presented with the opportunity to help supply audio bibles for Pakistan. The technology enables multiple languages and alows the visually impaired to have access to God's Word along with all other believers. PRAYER CALENDAR

PEARL 22

1 Pray that the Word would be a lamp of light and warmth to every person. Declare the Truth to penetrate deception and bring freedom. 3 Rebuke the spirit of perversion influencing the West, and pray that God would bring conviction of the wicked things, so that repentance may come.

GLOBAL CHURCH 4 Pray for the mercy of God on the Church and the enabling to be humble and righteous in the blood of Jesus, washed, cleansed, filled with desire to please God. Pray that the church be not mere hearers of the Word but doers of the Word.

With daily monitoring by Buddhist Federation, pray for believers and pastors to be wise as serpents and harmless or device. as doves.

13&14 Allow God to search your heart and reveal anything that holds you back or enslaves you. Lay those things down at the cross, repent before the Lord, and follow his leading to freedom.
