It was the first time she had seen her younger son Robinson in 15 years. It was also her birthday.

The brothers Bobby and Robinson flew to Nagpur in August to spend some much needed family time with their dear mother, and also encourage those who have received bibles and seek out connections and further needs for MO projects.

Arriving in hot and humid Nagpur, it was an amazing moment for the brothers to be greeted by their family and friends who came to welcome them with smiles, hugs, kisses, garlands, and tears of joy.

God made a way for this time, a provision of all grace and finances for both Robinson and his family at home. In Tauranga, Robinson's wife Esther held the fort on the home front with their two children, and in the ministry of Father's House Church and LifeTalk gospel radio. God was moving powerfully in the meetings!

Robinson was able to meet with 25 pastors in and around Nagpur and got an amazing report about the distributed bibles funded by MO supporters. There has been a great harvest of souls for the Kingdom of God, and over 25 churches have been started! The pastors are all so thankful to all who have been part of this in their prayer and giving. And there are many more souls to win.

Who Holds the Future

Outside an Islamic Primary School were the words **WE HOLD THE FUTURE** which sent shivers down my spine.

The next generation of children in Uganda are growing up in a world where Islam's agenda is to educate all the children in Africa. This had fresh impact on me during our visit to Uganda in June this year.

Pastors are desperate to turn their churches into schools during the week to teach children of Who God is and His ways.

Pastor John and Ruth and the many Pastors we were with in Mt Elgon and Buyende are more passionate than ever to keep fighting the good fight against the Islamic agenda to Islamise Africa every 100 metres with a mosque, clinic or school.

Islam has so much money to lure poor families to their schools, where no school fees are required. And God speaks to us, "Blessed are those who take care of the poor." (Prov.14:21) In the western world, pastors face a variety of issues, but in places like Uganda, the overwhelming issue is clear - poverty, and the great vulnerabilities that brings.



Pastor John and Ruth, along with many pastors in training, and also Dr Edward are dealing with poverty in Uganda 24/7. With generous help, this year Pastor John now has land and a harvested crop of maize harvested and ready to feed the

many that live with him. This is a huge achievement blessed by God despite threats of termites and thieves. This is one of many endeavours to minister to the poor, as the needs are continually great.

Dr Edward with his wife and nurse are providing medical care 24/7 in Buyende, a very poor area. Pastor John takes us there each time we're with him. The poverty makes people so vulnerable to sickness.

The frustrating breakdown of the Toyota Prado 4WD 3 times in the last week we were with John caused serious disruption to our plans and required so much money to fix. Feeling despondent and needing to pass the time until the vehicle was fixed, we set off to visit Proscovia, a beautiful mum who we'd helped 2 years ago.

She was so happy to see us, her joyful countenance revealing her deep joy within. The wall at the back of her



home had a big crack which she was worried could collapse. Thankfully her dear son Jonathan has made bricks ready to make another home for her on her property. In her garden there grows every

vegetable possible, banana, pawpaw, plus coffee! Her conversation is full of, "I'm alive... I have Jesus... I'm healthy... I'M RICH." As Proscovia prepared a gift for us to take back to Pastor John and Ruth, we wondered how we could be anxious about a vehicle breaking down when Proscovia is so rich with what we'd consider so little? As we sat with her in her humble wee dwelling, God revived our spirits.

Proscovia's gift was unusually prepared (at least to us!). A live chicken, legs tied, wings tied, and placed in a bag with its head poking out! The chicken was about ready to lay eggs for John and Ruth. A kind and generous gift.

While waiting for the Prado to be fixed, we also had plenty of time to just be in the company of many Ugandan people, both adults and children, which we loved. Ugandans are like one big happy family with no fences between their homes in the villages. We loved being back in their Toyota Taxi vans crammed in with beautiful, friendly folks. Though not quite so happy on the back of 100cc motor bikes racing along in the dust!

With such an example of generosity, community and joy amongst those with what we think is so little, it encourages us to let go of trivial concerns in the light of God's goodness and love. It also drives us to prayer for an end to poverty and to pray for the vulnerable to be established in the goodness, truth and love of God, knowing their future is in the Lord and no other.

Reformation in Myanmar

The Word has power and sustains the spirit of man, "Man does not live by bread alone but by every word proceeding from the mouth of God." (Deut.8:3) But how would it sustain if not understood? The impact of a reformation in common people being able to understand the Word of God has been seen before in 1517 where it was published in a common tongue. In this decade our Pearl 22 vision to fund one million bibles to restricted nations carries the same power of the Holy Spirit as we supply the Word of God to people in their common language.

Now for Myanmar, Mission Outreach has partnered with Asia Harvest to print and distribute the written Word of God in an 'easy to read' version.

We are rejoicing that 20,000 bibles have now made it through the war zones of Myanmar safely and are ready for distribution. A large portion of these have been funded by MO as our goal was 40,000 bibles, so we are nearly halfway there!

Now even the people in the poor areas, slums and prisons have the opportunity to understand and receive all the blessings Jesus has paid to give them. Let the fires of reformation and revival be set ablaze in hearts, families, communities and across the nation!

Not only are these bibles received by families with tears of joy, we have, I believe, also touched the heart of God, who has helped us make this possible.

Please continue to give so we can complete the second delivery of 20,000 bibles!



An Amazing Opportunity

When the founder of the Apostle FM Radio Station was killed suddenly in a plane crash in central Nepal last year, the family approached Pastor Samuel to ask if he would be interested in purchasing the radio station.

After prayer and discussions with mentors, we decided that this was an amazing opportunity not to be missed. Pastor Samuel has been broadcasting gospel messages on this station for over 10 years. This purchase would secure much more radio air space for gospel messages and worship music.

The generosity of Mission Outreach supporters and some friends of Samuel's in America made it possible to purchase the radio station and all the equipment, including the antenna and the FM license.

The station will now be broadcasting worship, gospel messages and teaching for 18 hours a day to a potential audience of about 1 million people.

Samuel has been busy putting together a team that will be involved in programming and advertising so that the station can be self-funding. Listeners will also now be able to call the station and request a New Testament, gospel tracts or other teaching materials. These will be sent out to the listeners at no charge.

We are very excited to be able to partner with the Apostle FM Radio Station and Radio Ministry, and have this complement our other endeavours in Nepal of training men and women and children, and printing bibles and teaching materials. What an unforeseen yet amazing opportunity for expanding the Kingdom of God via the airwaves!

HEALTH

1 Pray for our director Neil for full recovery from heart surgery in July. Speak rest and peace and regeneration to both his physical heart and his soul.

2 Make declarations of life, let faith arise in hearts and ask God to go before His people to strengthen them in the midst of battle. Rejoice that He hears our cries. Praise Him for being our Rock, Fortress, Deliverer and Shield.

3 Rebuke the devourer over God's people and bind the spirit of infirmity. Speak healing and wholeness over these ones taking ground for the Kingdom of God: Robinson & Esther, Pastor E, Bruce & Dorothy, Samuel & Mangali, Warren & Jolene, John & Ruth, and Paul.

4 Declare that time spent in the 'waiting room' would bring greater intimacy and vision from the Lord, and bring even more fruitfulness for the Kingdom of God in the next season.

5 Declare God's purposes revealed in this season. Pray for the taking of territory in the Spirit and the advancing of the Kingdom personally and in spheres of influence.

NEPAL

6 Pray for Samuel Rai as his begins five weeks of travel to USA, Malaysia and Japan. Pray for safe travel and no jet lag. Pray for a fruitful, blessed and strategic time with key people. Pray that ministries in Nepal would carry on well while Samuel is away.

7&8 Pray for the Apostle FM Radio Station as it gathers momentum. Ask for God's orchestration of personnel and management of operations. Pray for protection over equipment and systems and that the broadcasts would be a source of spiritual life and truth.

9 Pray that the radio waves would go out like lightning bringing a powerful impact of the presence and power of God to people's lives because 'the entrance of His Word brings light (Ps.119:130).

10 Declare that with this radio station the Kingdom of God will surpass the prince of the power of the air, for darkness can never overcome light (Jn 1:5).

11 Pray for the new intake of Deborah ladies last month. Pray that they receive

a baptism of love, and reflect the glory of the Lord everywhere they go.

12 Pray that the vision to make disciples of all nations through bibles going out be cast and caught far and wide. Pray for provision from God's storehouse, that finances would continue to be released for the bible projects. Pray that every request for bibles will be fulfilled.

GLOBAL CHURCH

13 Pray for repentance to come on the Church of the West for neglecting evangelism. Pray God's people rise up filled with Holy Spirit and the radiant glory of the Lord to push back darkness, and see the harvest. Pray the Church will truly become 'the Light of the World, and would sow the truth of Jesus Christ far and wide, and reap this harvest while it is yet day.

PERSECUTED CHURCH

14&15 Pray for a way forward for those struggling with things beyond their control. Pray they can surrender their burdens to Jesus. Pray for breakthrough. Ask for His presence, power, strength and peace to come on those suffering through persecution.

ISRAEL

16 Pray for the peace of Jerusalem. Pray for justice, the restraint of evil, and the hand of the Lord to act for His people. Ask for the mercy of God on people in revelation of their desperate need for Him, and responding with faith.

PAKISTAN

17 Praise God for the opportunity to help with 500 audio bibles. Pray these bibles function correctly and that the church is established in truth and Jesus love.

INDIA

18 With flood and sewerage damage to Pastor E's home again, pray for a new living arrangement that is safe, dry and clean, and not subject to the monsoon flooding. Pray that just as The Lord prepares a home for her in heaven, ask for a good home for her on earth.

CAMBODIA

19 Give praise to God for many seeds of the gospel sown to the people groups of this nation, and ask for increase. Pray for barriers to be destroyed and hearts open to receive the grace of God. Pray for lives to be transformed and the Kingdom to come to every heart.

20 Pray for anointed five fold leaders to rise up in faith and unity. Pray they are united with compassion and love as they gather to pray. Pray for humility to work together to build the Kingdom of God. Pray for churches to be built up, encouraged and equipped for every good work.

21&22 Pray for young ones to be invested in discipleship, and grow in boldness and a deep hunger for the Lord. Pray for the Prime Minister who has a Christian faith, to increase in favour and anointing of the Spirit.

23 Pray against corruption and for purity and justice. Pray that human trafficking would come under God's jurisdiction. Release righteousness. Ask the Lord to move in this nation, drawing them together in justice.

UGANDA

24 Praise God for Pastor John's early harvest of maize and that the termites were dealt with! Pray for protection over this harvest from thieves. Pray for human and angelic security guards. Pray for miraculous multiplication as it is given to the hungry.

25 Praise God for reconciliation of Pastor John and Ruth with their daughter Meek who is now living in Saudi Arabia. Pray that she finds trustworthy employment, and is kept from danger.

26 Pray for Pastor John and the pastors he trains. Pray for health, strength, resources, encouragement and works of faith, healing, deliverances, and strategies. Pray for the Kingdom of God to increase and take ground from the enemy of our souls. (Isa.9:7).

USA

27 For Warren and Jolene, pray for a covering of divine healing, and a guard over their hearts. Pray for healing, wholeness, and strength to be restored in body and spirit for them both.

NEW ZEALAND

28&29 Praise God that Phil and Sarah's steps are ordered by the Lord. Agree for divine appointments and heart connections. Come against any barriers to the establishing of supporters as they share their vision in the South Island.

30 Pray for Paul, faithful minister to China, for a creative miracle of a new heart valve. Pray he completes all that God has prepared for him to do.

PEARL 22

1 Pray for encouragement for every person reading the Word, for consolation, healing and hope leaping out of the words, and their spirits lifted.

2 Thank God for the continued supply of funds for bibles. Pray that the storehouses of heaven would continue to open in increasing measure. Pray for wisdom for MO, that effectiveness be multiplied. Praise God for future 1000s of lives changed.

3 Bless MO supporters. Pray they would flourish in business. Pray for encouragement and strength, knowing the hand and the smile of the Lord is upon them.

KENYA

4 Pray for Dr Rev Lamech who will run several church planter training seminars in different locations from 5th to 9th. Pray for the coordinators and the 900 trainees, for equipping and impartation, resulting in effective discipleship or target areas.

UGANDA

5&6 Pray for a dissatisfaction in witchcraft and Islam, speak confusion into the enemy's camp. Pray that deception be brought into the light and that by the power of Holy Spirit this nation would turn away from wicked influences, and be washed and set free in the Blood of Christ.

7 Pray for a Christian doctor who left his job in the city to start a 24/7 village clinic with his wife and another nurse. Pray for great impact for the village and the Kingdom of God.

8 With 53.5% of the population aged 14 and under, agree for a spearhead of young people exponentially growing in the joy of the Lord and leading an army of believers. Declare these young ones to be the hands and feet of Jesus, to show the way to others.

GLOBAL CHURCH

9 Pray that God's people fan the flames of revival, and ignite the fire of the gospel once more. Pray false religion would bow to Jesus, and believers would be on fire, confident in the Lord. Declare the gates of hell will not prevail. Thank God for victory in His name.

10 Ask God for willingness to be put in places He wants us to be, in the right

place at the right time for divine encounters. Ask for a multiplication of testimonies in lives through obedience.

11 Ask God that the Church will fulfil it's call and release history makers and nation changers.

AFRICA

12&13 Pray that the Kingdom of God would plunder any resources of the enemy. Pray that money intended to push evil agendas such as Islam would be reassigned and used for the extending of the Gospel far and wide.

PERSECUTED CHURCH

14 Pray for Bible deliveries into the Middle East. Pray for covering and protection for all involved. Bind all hindrance and speak favour. Pray for the success of every mission.

15 When God's people struggle with understanding situations at times, pray they would lean into Him and that the peace of God would transcend understanding. Pray for emptying of self and letting God transcend minds and hearts. Pray for anchoring hope in God and active faith.

AFGHANISTAN

16 Pray for our brothers and sisters who lay down their lives daily, not knowing what is ahead. Where there has been so much destruction, pray for the restoration promised to Joel in the pouring out of the Spirit on all flesh.

17 Pray for the restoration of women, rising up with purpose in the Lord and in the spirit of Esther. Pray that their strength in private would move mountains in the nation, and dignity would be restored.

ISRAEL

18 Ask for God's pouring out of wisdom and peace on the Prime Minister and government to know their desperate need of God, and to allow God to give wisdom, understanding and strategy. Pray that the IDF would work in unity.

TURKEY

19&20 Speak blessing over God's people in this nation. Agree for God to move, and ask Him to put a hedge of protection around them and station angels. Pray they would know the Peace that passes understanding.

NEPAL

21 Pray that the effect of the Apostle FM Radio broadcast would increase and multiply under Samuel & the team. Pray for the right program and messages that they have a great impact on the listeners.

22 Pray that everyone who hears the broadcast would hear the truth about Jesus and know He is the Son of God. Pray that the light and truth people seek and search for would be found in the broadcasts.

23 Praise God for the medical clinics. Pray many would be drawn to them and blessed in body, soul and spirit. Pray for protection and guidance for those managing them.

24 Pray for Chitwan pastors to embrace servant leadership. Pray for the preparation for another 'bibles on bikes' motorbike outreach. Pray for finances for the bibles, good weather and safety in travel and preparation of hearts to receive the Word.

CAMBODIA

25 Pray for Sabun and the team working for Prison Fellowship. Pray for strength, encouragement and provision. Pray for attentive ears to hear what He says and for a new move of Holy Spirit, filling them with grace and mercy and empowering them for every good work.

26&27 Pray for healing and protection on Sabun, his wife and son, that they would possess the promises and purposes of God. Ask for mighty power as they step out in faith.

28 Ask God to move sovereignly in this nation, that His will be done as it is being done in heaven. Ask He move on people in this land, to put aside foolishness & sinfulness. Pray there would be a cry in their heart for God to move, to have His way.
