The Power of the Word

As we began the new calendar year, we also entered into the 50th year of Misson Outreach. When we reflect on what this means we can't help but think about the founder of MO, Brother Eddie Cairns.

Those of us who worked with Eddie will remember that he was a man of God's Word. He loved reading God's Word, he loved preaching from God's Word and he dedicated his life to getting God's Word into the hands of those who didn't have access to it.

Why did Eddie Cairns dedicate his life to God's word? We believe it is because Eddie understood clearly the power and purpose of God's word. The light and hope it holds, has the power to cancel darkness, "The entrance of your word gives light," (Psalm 119:130), it is a lamp for direction and safety, "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path," (Psalm 119:105), and it is a sword of discernment and judgement, "For the word of God is living and active. Sharper than any two-edged sword, it penetrates even to the dividing of soul and spirit, joints and marrow, it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart." (Hebrews 4:12)

It is interesting that God put it on Eddie's heart to get the Word into nations where many of the leaders had vowed to wipe out God's word from their country.

One obedient man avails much more than leaders of nations. Voltaire, the 18th century literary genius, predicted that within 100 years of his day the Bible would only exist in museums. But he was wrong as Jesus said, "Heaven and earth will pass away but my words will never pass away." (Matthew 24:35)

The Bible, God's written word, continues to be the most sought-after book year after year.

Let me tell you about a testimony that I have just read recently. It has inspired in me even more urgency and zeal to get the Word into the nations. This true story is in a book written by Nic Ripken an American Missionary.

After returning to America from Somalia, Nic felt the Holy Spirit lead him to research the storeis of several Christians on their preparation and response to persecution.

He first did interviews in countries of Eastern Europe and Asia. After that, Nic received invitations to do his research into four South East Asian nations. So he finalised travel plans to visit the four nations. Then an email came, firmly requesting that he come to their Muslim majority nation.

However, Nic turned down this late request since his plans were already made.

In due course, one of the four nations pulled out for security reasons and another withdrew as the interviewee had been in a car accident.

As a result, Nic saw that God was indicating he was to change his plans and go to the Muslim nation after all.

Power of the Word ...

After landing in their country, Nic was met by five ex Muslim Christian men who took him to their hotel. There they shared with him their miraculous journeys to faith in Jesus.

Each man shared about how they had been led by dreams and visions to find God's word.

One man's dream was to go to the Muslim book store and look for the "blue book" in amongst hundreds of green Korans. Sure enough there was one blue Bible tucked away amongst all the green Korans!

Another was told in his dream to go to a certain stall in the market place. There someone would give them a Bible.

After each one read their Bible right through, some several times through, they each surrendered their life to Jesus Christ. In their reading, the Author had truly shown up to encounter them!

Nic was so taken by what these men shared he cried out to God, "How did these men get Your word?" God led him to Acts 8:26-40, where Philip obeys the Angel of the Lord and goes to meet an Ethiopian Eunuch on the road to Gaza. Clearly it is not too hard for God to set up situations where people can encounter Him in the Word.

Nic's next question to God was, how did a servant to a heathen Queen get this scroll? And how was he allowed to read it when only those authorised by the Priest were allowed to? How did a non-Hebrew get this scroll and how did he afford it?

God answered Nic this way, "I have been doing this for thousands of years. If you will get My word into these

countries, I will see that it gets into the hands of those who need it." God loves to make fruitful every sowing, every distribution of His Word, for it shall not return void but accomplish His purpose (Isa.55:11).

Wow! Wow! All glory to our great God who makes a way for His Word.

Let us not cease praying for souls to encounter the Saviour through dreams and visions and the revelation of His Word.

Let us not cease investing prayerfully and financially in the distribution of the Word.

We at MO, like our founder Eddie Cairns, are convinced more than ever in this Jubilee year to continue getting the Word into nations. And God will make it fruitful, for the power of the Word, the light cancelling darkness, the lamp of direction and safety, and the sword of discernment and judgement can be encountered by every soul.

If we will do our part, God will do His part.



Fasting & Ramadan

As Muslims start their spiritual journey of Ramadan, let us be praying that in their devotion, Yahweh God would meet them.

Corporate and individual prayer and fasting is a spiritual discipline taught in the Bible, and Jesus expects it of his followers. It is powerful for faith and intimacy with God and positioning of oneself to seek Jesus. The denying of food and habits can break any hold they may have, and strengthen one's spirit to overcome and hear from God.

It is more than just abstinence, but is about replacing the physical with the spiritual. Rather than feeding the body with natural food, the spirit feasts on the spiritual food of the Word of God, finding satisfaction in God alone.

Muslims also see great value in fasting especially during Ramadan as the observance of Ramadan is a core duty of a Muslim, fasting being one of the five pillars of Islam. In this season of Ramadan, let us pray for Muslims as they position themselves to receive, that their hearts would be free of deception to receive from their loving Father.

Pray that rather than trusting in their own good works and devotion, they would come to understand and trust in Jesus the only Saviour.

And he said to them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the labourers are few. Therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out labourers into his harvest" Luke 10:2 (ESV)



1986-1995 Where is Eddie?

The MO Prayer Room was in full swing and it was often asked in the meeting 'Where is Eddie?' He very rarely stood still, always planning his next trip to encourage the body of Christ whether it be in New Zealand or in Access Restricted Nations. He always encouraged the body of Christ to help fund the purchase of bibles or help brothers in the Lord with whatever their needs were.

God connected Eddie with many amazing people during the early decades and never failed to provide for him, his family and the many teams he lead in the nations God sent him to.

His challenge was to pray, give and go and to walk in faith as God constantly challenged Eddie as well.

Account from 'To Catch the Wind' (page 127) when Eddie and Ivan were trying to get into North Korea:

""What is your business?" Asked one of the men seated across the massive table. "I am the director of a New Zealand company called Higher Enterprises," I said. Then I introduced Ivan to the men.

"How many ships does your company own? How many thousand people work for you?" I began to feel weak. I had neither ships nor workmen. He asked, "How many million dollars do you turn over per annum?"

God called him to China, North Korea, Myanmar, Philippines, Cambodia, Vietnam and Tibet to name a few.

In those days, it was very challenging and often dangerous, for Eddie and his teams to get their 'Bread' into the people's hands.

His faith and determination had Eddie's angels constantly in alert mode performing miracles whether it be to extend the miles of an empty fuel tank, to allowing a raging fire in Vietnam as a distraction so his team could deliver their mountain of hibles

Eddie thrust himself and others into the Mission field to serve, encourage and carry the ever needed Word of God to God's people overseas.

I was losing ground fast. All I could see in my mind's eye was the prison doors slamming behind us.

..... All of a sudden, the Lord reminded me of the promise He had given me the night before I departed from the Philippines.

It was found in Jeremiah 1:17 "Therefore gird up your loins and arise, and speak to them all that I command you. Do not be dismayed at their faces, Lest I confound you before them."

I wasn't even allowed to get scared!"

Account from page 161 of Eddie's book:

"Let's go and see what's happening out there," I told the team. We joined the jostling, chattering crowd that had flocked to the towering inferno. A fourteen-storey building was completely ablaze..... I moved closer to watch several fire engines.... Their water hoses were not carrying enough pressure to start dampening down the fire. The blaze was totally out of control and threatened to engulf the entire block of buildings - including our hotel.

I looked at my watch. We were just minutes away from our rendevous time. "Come on!" I called above the noise of the burgeoning crowd, "We have a job to do!"

We hurried back to the hotel and loaded our bags with the Vietnamese Scriptures. There wasn't a soul to be seen in the reception area.

Our drivers hardly noticed us as We loaded our bags into the transport and joined them gazing in awe as the powerful flames devoured the tall structure. What was a tragedy for others, had become a blessing for us. For whatever the reason, God had allowed this disaster, it had become a cover for us."

It was Monday night when a group of nine people gathered in our Mission Outreach office. As I looked around the room, I had to smile. Here we were, a very ordinary group of Kiwis living at the bottom of the earth in a land of 70 million sheep and only 3.4 million people, far removed from other nations. What a difference could we possibly make in the affairs of the world?

18 Pray as the Church celebrates the life of Jesus poured out and given to death as a final payment for sin, a revelation of the deep unending love of God for His people would be revealed. Pray this revelation would heal and revive hearts and move them to share this precious gift for all.

RESURRECTION DAY

19&20 Celebrate victory over the grave for all who trust in Jesus! Pray that this message of hope, that death no longer has the final say, would be preached and received far and wide today. Stand in the authority Jesus has won.
