# June 2011 - Eddie's Final Front Page

It is with measurable sadness I express my love and gratitude to you, in this my final letter of greeting. My health has deteriorated over the past few months and with this concern, I have sought the Lord regarding my role on the Board of Mission Outreach.



My heart toward you is that of David as he speaks in Psalm 16:2-3, 'I said to the Lord, You are my Lord, apart from you I have no good thing. As for the saints who are in the land, they are the glorious ones in whom is all my delight.'

You have so been my delight, as together we have loved and served our risen Lord and Saviour, the King of Kings. In Philippians 2:1-2, Paul writes, 'If you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from His love, if any fellowship with the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and purpose.' I thank you that I have experienced the beauty of the love of Jesus through you all. Both through your love and hospitality, to me personally, and through the oneness of spirit we have shared in serving the Lord in the building of His Kingdom.

# A Decade of Challenges, Change & Opportunities

Reflecting on the decade from 2006 to 2015, we are so encouraged and blessed by all that the Lord did during this period. It also had many challenges as Eddie's health deteriorated after suffering strokes. So, it also became a decade of changes for Eddie, Betty and their family as well as the Mission.

The years from 2006 to 2015 were also a time of great activity in Mission Outreach and very fruitful with many overseas trips with Eddie in the early part of the decade as During this decade, MO worked closely with Samuel Rai in well as Neil, Steve, Alvin and others. Each year many of the MO board attended the Ethnos Asia (EA) annual conferences in Bangkok, we also supported many training schools - one in the Philippines with Rey Awatin of Tribes in Asia for Christ, the Myanmar GIFT training centre through EA, the Richet training centre on the Tibet/Nepal border and continued to support the Nepal Bible College through GTN (Gospel of Tribes and Nations).

With all that said, the purchase of bibles for the brethren in China, Vietnam. Laos, Myanmar, India, Tibet, the Uyghur and Nepal was always at the forefront of our committment to the body of Christ.



Change came when Eddie suffered a stroke during the early part of this decade, yet he never gave up desiring to go back to Asia. His heart for the believers in the Restricted Access nations drew him and Betty yet again to China in 2012 accompanied by Sonny and Dahlia Largado of Ethnos Asia. (See pic on left).

It was during this trip they met Pastor Anh Lao and many other 'comrades in faith' who had participated in the Project Pearl One million bible delivery of 1981. It was during these exciting and emotional meetings Eddie heard first hand that the 'Pearl Bibles' were distributed to 39 of China's 58 provinces and resulted in the enormous growth of the Chinese Church. (See page 240 of 'to Catch the Wind'.)

Nepal with provision of bibles, equipping pastors and leaders and building the training centre at Richet which

became a hub for training and sharing the gospel.

From 2007 to 2013. Samuel also held several large gospel crusades in various parts of Nepal (see pic on right). These were a



very effective way to reach the lost. During the crusades, Samuel always took the opportunity to invite local government officials. He honoured them by allowing them to speak to the people, then Samuel shared the gospel. Hundreds of people completed response cards inviting the church teams to visit them and share more about Jesus.

In 2015, Eddie attended the 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Ho Chi Minh City Church in which he had played a significant role in establishing this church with Tran Mai. This was to be his last trip overseas. (See excerpt below from Eddie's book.)

# **Excerpts from 'To Catch the Wind'**

# Page 240:

In 2010 former Chairman, Stephen Woolley received the devastating news of bowel cancer and undertook an intensive course of chemotherapy. 'Although the operation was successful and Stephen was given an all clear, he sensed it was time to hand over the leadership reigns of Mission Outreach. Eddie who had already suffered strokes, also decided it was time for him to step down...' So it was, that both Stephen and Jenny, Eddie and Betty resigned from Mission Outreach board.

This was a sad time for the MO Board, at the same time it created new opportunities, so it was that Alvin Allan, who had been a faithful participant in the prayer room and board member, took over as Mission Outreach Director.

For the next few years, he extended the work of the mission by leading teams into the Middle East, Pakistan and Afghanistan. The main emphasis of these outreaches was to pray on the land and encourage the believers.'

In 2015 Pastor Tran Mai from Vietnam invited Eddie to attend the 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Ho Chi Minh City Church. By now Eddie needed a stick to walk. To travel he would need a wheelchair. ... But Eddie was determined to go.... His Tauranga pastors, David and Linda Dishroon agreed to accompany Eddie. Betty's cousin Lloyd Passey and his wife Sharon generously offered to cover Eddie's costs and also go.

### Page 241:

'During the ministry time as he sat on a comfortable chair ... Pastors would come up one by one and kneel before him. Eddie then ministered to these hungy men and women with powerful words of prophecy and healing. ... It was during this ministry time that Eddie came alive. Weak as he was, you saw the spiritual strength of this man.'

During the return journey home, 'Eddie took a turn. When they landed in Singapore he was immediately taken by ambulance to hospital. .... During their time in Singapore Eddie's health had been so fragile, they were on constant alert the whole time. And indeed, this would prove to be Eddie's last ministry trip abroad.

12 Pray for "self-sufficient" nations and people to realise their desperate need of God for every good thing, even their breath.

Pray for hard hearts to soften with the kindness of the Lord leading them to repentance. Pray that the aging and those nearing death would have their hearts softened to receive the truth of the gospel to redeem their life.

13 Speak out peace to Jerusalem. Pray Israel would return to the living Messiah, Prince of Peace, and obey Him with all their heart and soul.

14 Pray that every scripture received by this people would bear the fruit of maturity in faith, and influence many others, expanding the Kingdom of God. Pray for the fire of passion for the Lord to move them.
