As a result MO Board members at the time - Alvin, Helen, Clive, Greg, Barry, Neil, Wendy, Mark and Marianne took turns writing the front page. The words shared were always inspiring and encouraging.

We continued to work closely with Ethnos Asia who ministered in Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, Laos, Cambodia, Vietnam, Myanmar, China, Pakistan, Afghanistan, NE India, Maldives etc and helping where we could with Disaster

Relief. MO also supported House of Hope Orphanages in India and Gospel to Tribes and Nations (GTN) in Nepal for training, crusades and bibles.

Teams continued to be taken into many of the countries lead by different board members. Neil worked faithfully with Samuel in Nepal, but also visited other nations such as Pakistan, a very memorable trip. Alvin was always keen for a challenge and set his sights on Afghanistan and Mark joined him along with some others. Getting feet on the ground to pray was an important part of working in these nations.

Changing Seasons...



In 2017, the first 'Wind & Fire' Conference was held in Nepal, the second in 2018. It was through these that an impartation of the Holy Spirit was released to those attending and set the stage for the exponential multiplication of believers in this nation. We are so privileged to have been part of this vision.

AUTUMN - 2018 & 2019:

Life is about changing seasons, and in 2018, Alvin and Helen made the decision to resign from MO as Director and Secretary. This was a difficult time for us all as we adjusted to a challenging change. We had to press in to each other and the Lord and seek and trust Him to be our Source and Provider.

With Helen gone, Wendy began writing the monthly newsletters again. It was at this time, we believed with a new season on us, it was also opportunity for a new look. We engaged a graphic designer (sponsored by supporters) to create the new design of the newsletter with a harvest field as the prominent feature on the front page. This has continued being our focus as God is so much about harvest and multiplication.

Flood disasters devastated many parts of Asia during 2018 and 2019.

The Church in China has endured another crisis of horrific persecution under the dictatorship of Xi Jinping. Throughout its history, it has always come through, albeit battered and bruised, to the other side by God's grace and power. We faithfully lifted this nation up in prayer as they navigated another terrible wave of persecution.

Excerpt from June 2019 report on the Power of God's Word: 'An aged blind man emerged from the back of the room and gently sat down on a stool before Pastor Wu. Old Lee's battered face radiated an inner joy. In his arms he cradled a wooden box, holding it closely to his chest as if it contained a priceless treasure, he shared his story...' We were blessed to have Samuel Rai and his wife Mangali visit us during July 2019. Samuel's vision from this year was to train and Equip 20,000 leaders and pastors to disciple their people and grow the church.



WINTER - 2020 & 2021:

We focused a lot on North Korea during 2020 and introduced Tibet to profile the need to help Tibetan leaders. The Lord lead us to share a lot about Afghanistan to release prayer in preparation for the supply of bibles to this nation.

In late 2020, after discussions with Eddie and Betty and with their blessing and agreement, we began the process of updating Eddie's book 'To Catch the Wind' by adding two new Forewords at the beginning and an Epilogue at the back of the book. Most of the work on this was done during 2021. After Eddie's passing, we sought the Cairns family's approval on the proposed additions. The book was finally completed and published in 2022.

Wendy and Neil would often visit Eddie and Betty in the retirement village I would have my iPad and show them photos of what MO was doing. Eddie was always interested and often asked when I was going on my next overseas ministry trip and could I take him with me. We always had a good time of prayer and Eddie always had an encouraging word even on our last visit he was talking about the Lord. We enjoyed our times with him and Betty.



The darkest time for the church across the globe was ushered in at the beginning of 2020. None of us will ever forget the effect Covid19 had on the world. So many restrictions, the impact of isolation, separation, starvation, illness, anxiety, fear, and hopelessness gripped many, impacting everyone. Jesus was our only comfort and hope.

WINTER - 2020 & 2021:

So many were not able to work, and hunger and daily survival became paramount issues. Many took their own lives and that of their children's rather than watch them starve to death. MO started a project to 'Feed the Hungry' in several nations, providing basic needs to alleviate help this.

It is during times of suffering and challenges, that doors to hearts and minds are opened. As the result of Covid, many opportunities for the gospel were created to share about Jesus and give hope where there was no hope. Our partners used these opportunities to reach out with the love of Jesus and gave hope to many.

December 2021 began with the loss of our dear brother in the Lord and founder of MO, Eddie Cairns, when he was called to glory on 5th December. Sadly, due to Covid restrictions still in force, only 50 people were permitted to attend his funeral. Under normal circumstances there would have been hundred's there to honour this amazing man of God.

SPRING - 2022 to 2025:

The end of Covid19 gave rise to new life, vision and many opportunities.

After a winter of challenges and loss, spring arrived in January 2022 when we began the new vision, birthed from Eddie's passing, of Pearl 22. A vision to facilitate the supply of one million bibles, in memory of Eddie's most treasured memory - Project Pearl in 1981.

This new vision was to facilitate bibles in many nations by partnering with supporters and organisations as the Lord lead and provided. It is a vision to grow the Body of Christ, and multiply souls in the Kingdom of God.

During these years, the training and equipping vision now know as Body Builders for Christ (BBC) continued in Nepal. Totals to date are tens of thousands of training materials printed, nearly 2,000 churches planted and almost 20,000 disciples made. All have been empowered to continue to take what they have learned to their leaders and churches. So the growth of the church in Nepal continues.

Without the Word of God - A Precious Treasure - A weapon for battle, the church will not grow. Pearl 22 which was inspired by Eddie's epic Project Pearl experience, named from Habbakkuk 2:2 and the year it started - 2022, has been confirmed many times that this is what MO is to do.



New partnerships have been formed and many nations touched with the Word of God. So often reports were received that the bibles were like 'Gold in their Hands'.

"How can we fight the enemy if we do not have a gun?" stated a Bible student during my August visit to Burundi and Uganda. She was speaking, of course, of the Word of God. I was amazed at the statement. To my joy I was able to look at the student and tell her she will get her Bible. She was beside herself with joy. ... The Bibles were like gold for them.

As the Lord has opened doors we have made divine connections with many people and ministries. Hundred's of thousands of New Testaments and bibles have been distributed into 20 nations since Pearl22 began.

In Nepal, the motorbike outreach during Easter of 2024 was an exciting first with 6,000 New Testaments released into the hands of hungry souls.

Christmas Crusades have become a regular event for Nepal also as this creates incredible opportunity to share the gospel to those in authority as well as to the people in each region.



We heard reports of revival in several nations such as Myanmar. On the other hand, our friends in India have seen an increase in persecution of Christians in response to the government's mandate and experienced it personally.

The weekly prayer meeting has continued every Monday night on Zoom, when we often pray around the world as the Lord leads. This has created opportunity for intercessors in Australia, Cambodia and other nations to join us from time to time. With persecution increasing in many nations, we continue to pray for our brothers and sisters in the Lord.

We are overwhelmed and in absolute awe of the provision and goodness of God through this decade. We feel so very privileged and honoured to be involved in the 'Father's Business' of Mission Outreach, helping to build His Kingdom through training and equipping pastors and leaders, funding the provision of Bibles, feeding the poor and needy, educating children, and wherever else the Lord has lead us.

We are so thankful to you all, our generous and praying supporters, because without you responding to the Holy Spirit's prompting, we could not achieve anything.

PEARL 22

1 Pray for a release of finances for bibles needed.

Pray for expansion so that more lives would be touched and equipped with the Word and the Spirit. Pray for God's purpose and vision be made clear to the MO board. Pray for open doors and hearts. Pray for continued strength in unity and humble obedience to 'take the ground' God indicates.

3 Pray for the MO Jubilee celebration to be held later this month. Pray it will be a time of rejoicing and fellowshiping in what God has done and how He continues to move in yielded vessels. Rejoice in every life touched.

PASTORS & LEADERS

4 Pray they can walk in the rest of God, by the Spirit of God.

HEALING

5 Pray for the healing of God's people. Declare every curse broken, declare victory and life through the finished work of Christ. Pray for Ps John & Ruth's 16 year old son, Favour, for healing. Pray for Pastor Ruth for healing from diabetes, and restored balance. Pray for full restoration of Phil's foot from severe infection, and for his baby son David's feet to grow straight. Pray for Robinson, Esther and family to live in 100% restored health.

GLOBAL

9 Pray for those weary in battle, that there would come people to 'hold up their hands' to remain in faith and victory, no matter what battle. Pray for protection over minds, hearts, bodies and spirits, not only holding onto faith but taking ground. Pray for impartation of faith and hope and peace that passes understanding. Pray for hope and change and strength to press through the battle.

CAMBODIA/THAILAND CONFLICT

10 Regarding the recent escalation of century long conflict between these nations. Pray that this situation would stir the churches of Cambodia and Thailand to intercession for one another and taking authority together to declare God's boundary of Cambodia and Thailand, and to declare the war to cease.

11 Pray for the leaders and the soldiers to encounter the Prince of Peace. Pray for humility, healing and forgiveness. Pray that the national leaders would have great wisdom, discernment, humility, and resilience. Pray that God's justice and truth would prevail.

12 Break off the spirit of murder from Cambodia, that it will no longer have any hold or influence. Declare the Blood of Jesus to cover Cambodia and Thailand as the final word.

PHILIPPINES

13&14 Pray for Jeth and the young adults he leads on Tuesday nights in open worship, prayer and discussing the Word. Also bless the community outreach.

15 Pray for Jeth's ministry to children at an orphanage. Bless his ministry through Holy Spirit to bring children from emotional scars to strong faith in Christ, knowing who God is, how to pray and hear from Him.

16 Pray for a new mission to the Philippine island of Ticao. Pray for divine protection on the missionaries and that hearts would be prepared to receive the gospel. Pray that missionaries would connect with people of peace in the community.

UGANDA

17 Pray for upcoming outreaches to be fuelled and effective through the love and compassion of God for his people. Pray that much ground would be taken for the Kingdom of God, and many families and communities redeemed.

18 Pray for Haggai who oversees 29 churches a bible college and a school which gives education to street children in Kampala. Pray for fresh anointing, divine wisdom and strategy for Haggai's leadership and this ministry. Pray for increasing impact for the Kingdom, more leaders, more teachers, more students, all maturing in faith.

KENYA

19 Praise God for the recent visit of Harvey and Robyn to their daughter and son-in-law Sarah and Phil in Kenya, as they become established in their mission there. Pray for joy in their hearts amidst various trials. Praise

God for foundations in the Spirit. Pray for restoration and momentum in the work God has prepared for them to do.

GLOBAL CHURCH

20&21 Pray Jesus be honoured as the Head of every church Body. Pray miracles flow.

22 Pray for God's people to have revival in their hearts, coming in unity in His strength to stand up, speak up and bring the gospel and the power of God. Pray God's people would know and fulfil the call of God in whatever they do.

23 Just as God broke down walls among Nepalese pastors in Nelson though the humble service of foot washing, pray that beautiful acts of humility and love would break pride and bring fellowship and healing between God's people.

24 Pray for anointing in the ministering of the living Word that pierces the darkness and evil. Pray that God's people would go out not in fear but in power of the Spirit, with wisdom, knowledge and discernment. Pray that as the Presence overshadows them, the enemy would flee and fall in repentance.

25 Pray for continued blessing on God's servants, for increase, peace, new encouragement, fulfilment, testimonies, and to know that their labour is not in vain.

26 Pray for boldness to come upon God's people to speak His Word in the midst of wars.

NEW ZEALAND

27&28 Praise God for Pastor John and Pujah ministering to Nepalese in Te Puke and Auckland. Pray that those disciplined would accelerate in their faith and zeal, and would influence and ignite many more. Pray that the ongoing discipleship would grow the church strong in faith and obedience.

29 Pray for more Nepalese in NZ to find connection and fellowship in the church and in Jesus. Declare the Nepalese to no longer be lost but found in Christ.

30 Pray for Gareth and Alicia running an outreach café in Edgecumbe. Bless their obedience and faith and pray for favour and every need will be met, and everything in their hearts will come to fruition and grow. Declare the light that rises on them dispels the darkness.

OCTOBER 2025

ISRAEL

1 Pray for Jews on this annual holy Day of Atonement (Yom Kippur) today. As they seek to put things right with God, pray for visions and revelations of Jesus the Messiah, the culmination of Yom Kippur by His work on the cross.

ZAMBIA

2 Pray for David as he ministers the power of the gospel to children in both rural and urban areas. Pray that the Word and Presence of God would continue to touch the children and mark them for eternity. Bless David's leadership.

3 Pray for the boys at the orphanage as they learn from David how to be a man of God, they would stand tall in their identity in Christ and become mighty men of influence.

4&5 Pray for the visits to rural areas where there are gangs seeking child recruits. Break off all witchcraft and strongholds of darkness so that the enemy's plans do not prosper. Pray for God's love, boldness and courage on the team to speak the word with signs following. Pray that the children would know the tangible presence of God in power and put their trust in the Lord.

ISRAEL

6 Pray for Jews as they celebrate the Feast of Tabernacles/Booths (Sukkot) for the next 7 days remembering the Exodus and time in the wilderness. Pray for great joy and revelation of redemption through Jesus the Messiah and freedom from bondage to new life in Christ.

PERSECUTED CHURCH

7 Pray that those in danger for their faith would rest under the shelter of the Almighty. Pray that as their war in the Spirit, operating in peace, love, gentleness and unity, they would be strengthened in faith and joy. Pray against any agreement with discouragement.

CHINA

8 Pray for our brothers and sisters in China where government wants to shut down house churches. Pray they remain strong in the power of Holy Spirit, in boldness, and not flinching but standing firm in the Word and in the call of God on their lives.

MYANMAR

9 Pray that with 3.5 million people having been displaced due to earthquakes and military force, the mainland and provincial churches would be united, embracing the spirit of revival. Pray that this love in the Body would be a powerful force and witness to the nation.

10 Pray that the displaced would reach out to one another in love, not giving in to fear. Pray that the church would be zealous in outreach to minister life and peace that are not dependant on circumstances.

11&12 Pray for protection on Christian villages under attack.

AFGHANISTAN

13 Pray for women and children forced out of Iran into Afghanistan. Ask God to intervene on their behalf.

CAMBODIA/THAILAND CONFLICT

14 Pray that this revival would draw many to church gatherings to seek after Peace, and find joy. Pray for the Word of God in letter and Spirit to flow in these nations.

15 Pray for practical needs of aid ministries especially to the vulnerable – the old, the young and the women. Pray for Sabun and family who live in Cambodia near the Thailand border. Pray for families being evacuated. Pray that those in fear and anxiety would lift their eyes to the Lord. Pray for children to feel peace, comfort and safety in God's hands.

16 Pray that the church would not shrink back but be bold in meeting needs because God is the Supplier.

INDIA

17 Pray for Ps E in India for God's sustaining grace, protection, and wisdom. Pray for provision of every need, and God's covering. Bless the fellowships of new believers that they would be grounded in the love of God and strengthened in faith.

18 & 19 Pray for the Hindu community celebrating Diwali today. Pray as they celebrate the victory of light, that Jesus the Light of the world would truly be revealed to them. Pray for scales of deception to fall in Jesus name, and let Jesus answer every heart's cry for the light of truth.

UGANDA

20 Commit every season of maize and other food crops as blessed of the Lord. Pray for abundant yield. Pray for the current maize crop to remain strong and healthy through to harvest in December.

21 Pray for favour and provision on Pastor John's plans to turn a church building in Zion Estate into a school during weekdays. Pray for completion by February next year. Pray it will be a beacon of truth and hope for the community. Raise God for the opportunity to set foundations of education beginning with the fear of the Lord, in the Zion Estate community.

22 Pray for children in this new Ugandan school, and other schools such as Emmanuel School in Nepal, that they be free in spirit and the teachers would be led by the Spirit of God. Pray that schools would be a refreshing place of enrichment in the Word.

23 Pray that children become disciples, know and understand the Lord, walking in the Spirit as mighty warriors, even for their families and communities. Pray that the seed of the Word of Truth brought back to their families would crush all religious deception. Pray that children be equipped in praying for the sick. Pray for humility among the older to learn from these younger ones.

24 Ask for release for every material and spiritual need for the children and schools, fitted buildings and toilets, food, care, attention and education.

NEPAL

25&26 Pray for preparations for the Christmas gospel crusades. Pray for provision of resources to print 25,000 New Testaments and venues. Pray for Holy Spirit to 'plough the land' in preparation for the 'seed' of the gospel. Pray against opposition to plans or to Samuel and for covering and anointing over the GTN team.

GLOBAL CHURCH

27 Pray God's people be knit together, not divided by offense but drawn in humility, forgiveness and sacrificial love.

28 Pray for evangelists to be sent out and see miracles, transformations, healings and the power of the gospel. Pray for boldness to share the love of God, peace, purpose and hope to hold onto. Pray hearts are stirred up and captured by the love of God.

29 Pray for every heart to be one of obedience an surrender to the Lord, receiving the needed 'oil' to keep the lamp of the heart burning with passion for Jesus.

NEW ZEALAND

30 Bless everything Robinson and Esther put their hand to – radio, church, visiting, family life. Contend for healing of Robinson's nasal passages to free up his breathing.

31 Pray many be raised up to reach out with the Love of Jesus and bless others. Pray our government will yield to the Living God and His righteousness. Pray that with every effort of missionaries, the Lord will provide, strengthen them and open doors, and release testimonies of God's goodness.
