Every Bible and teaching resource we distribute carries no MO logo, because our desire is to lift up the name of the Lord, not our own.

Throughout 2025, Mission Outreach celebrated 50 years of service.

From that foundation, we look to the future with gratitude and purpose. Our ongoing Pearl22 Project—to place one million Bibles into the hands of those who need them most—remains our central focus.

Recent printings include 20,000 New Testaments for Nepal and 20,000 Bibles for India, where believers face growing persecution yet stand strong in faith. In several middle Eastern countries, many are coming to Jesus—hungry for His Word.

In Cambodia, a nation once stained by genocide, revival is now flourishing, and the need for Bibles has never been greater. I remember smuggling Bibles into this nation when Pol Pot was still murdering the people and we prayed over the killing fields where the blood of the martyrs soaked the land. From Uganda to China, where our mission began with the 1981 Project Pearl delivery, the call for Scripture continues.

The Word of God is alive and powerful. The needs are immense, but we serve a limitless God. As we enter a new year, our confidence rests in Him who provides for every need.

Thank you for standing with Mission Outreach.

Together, we will continue to bring the living Word to those still waiting to receive it.

# Our Pearl of Great Price - Pearl 22

**Pearl 22 is Mission Outreach's bold vision to distribute one million Bibles (full Bibles or New Testaments) to believers around the world, particularly in restricted-access nations. Through your faithful support, MO has been able to send funds to trusted partners overseas who safely purchase and distribute the Scriptures where they are most needed.**

Since Pearl 22 was launched in January 2022 approximately 200,000 Bibles have been distributed across many nations, including various Middle Eastern nations, Bhutan, Burundi, Cambodia, China, India, Myanmar, Nepal, Ukraine, Philippines and various African nations including Uganda, Kenya, and Zambia. Each delivery represents lives touched and communities strengthened by the power of God's Word.

In Nepal, 20,000 more New Testaments have recently been printed—each including Psalms, Proverbs, and key questions commonly asked by Hindus about the Christian faith. These unique editions, produced only by our contact and printed locally in the tens of thousands, are a valuable resource for new believers and seekers.

In Uganda, one young girl who was given money by her mother for food, chose instead to purchase a Bible out of her desperation to get the Word of God. Pastor J joyfully gave her his last copy provided by MO without cost so she could still buy her chapati. In India, the Gospel continues to flourish despite fierce opposition.

From remote and impoverished regions around the world, believers are continually saying "bring us more Bibles". Free Bible distribution across rural regions of India has sparked new fellowships and home groups, uniting families in prayer and study. Pastor X and her team have shown extraordinary courage, even after a church in Uttar Pradesh was burned down for its Christian witness. Undeterred, they continue distributing Bibles with MO's support – "The building was destroyed, but the Word of God cannot be burned."

Across continents, Pearl 22 testifies that even under persecution, poverty, and false gods, the Word of God endures. MO gives heartfelt thanks to all supporters whose generosity continues to place Scripture into the hands of those longing for truth and transformation.

**Praise Report from India:** With hearts full of gratitude, we thank each of you for your prayers, support, and generous contributions toward the free Bible distribution in one of India's most challenging regions. # A People of Faith and Resilience

**The Mangyan are the indigenous heart of Mindoro Island in the Philippines. A collective name for eight distinct ethnolinguistic groups who are the island's original inhabitants. With a history stretching back to pre-colonial times, they possess a rich cultural heritage, including unique, pre-Spanish syllabic writing systems. Despite their deep cultural roots, many Mangyan communities face significant socio-economic challenges, grappling with poverty and limited access to essential services.**



For the past four years, Mission Outreach partner organisation has been supporting the Mangyan people. This initiative has reached close to 1,000 people with Bibles, and several youth Bible teaching programs are actively being conducted at the affiliated base in Baco, Mindoro. This spiritual support has been met with incredible enthusiasm.

This November, a board member visited a remote Mangyan village, a vibrant community that, despite having no electricity or internet, is filled with a deep love for God and His Word. As part of Project "Pearl 22," the mission provided Bibles, and the community's joy in receiving them was a powerful testament to their faith, surpassing their lack of basic amenities. During this visit, the mission also helped conduct a primary health care program for 250 people and organized a feeding program for the community.

This holistic support is a collaborative effort and Mission Outreach has made significant contributions by building sanitary toilets and showers and participating in feeding programs at several schools. With plans to visit again next year, the mission continues to build a strong relationship with the resilient Mangyan people, empowering them through both spiritual and practical support.



## Empowering Women, Nepal

**Nepal is one of the poorest countries globally, with a majority relying on agricultural with 95% of the land being hilly and lacking irrigation. This makes it very difficult for the people to sustain themselves even for six months. Hence, many seek work in elsewhere, leaving their daughters in villages facing early marriage or human trafficking due to limited knowledge and teachers to guide them.**

As a result, human trafficking has become a major risk for these young women who are seconded from as young as 14 years old, and often lured to brothels in India. There is an estimated 2 million Nepalese women who have become victims of this.

The Deborah Women's Empowerment Training Programme in Nepal provides skill based training to Christian widows and vulnerable young women, enabling them to lead safe and self-reliant lives.

The trainees attend the course for 5 months where they study the Word of God, and are taught sewing and tailoring and given basic health education. During their stay, they are provided with free food and lodging for the 5 month training period. The trainees are provided with health education for two weeks in the during the last month of their training. The education on health is provided by the health workers or nurses accredited by the Government of Nepal.

The purpose of health education is to eradicate false beliefs among the villagers who use witchcraft practices of 'Dhami' and 'Jhakri' which oppose medical treatment often leading to premature death. The trainees will be able to work as health consultants in their village and provide health awareness to the villagers. The bible training also helps the women to spread the Gospel of God and often a church is established in the villages.

### KENYA

**21** Pray for refreshment on Phil and Sarah, encouragement and renewed

vision and compassion. Pray that rhema from the Lord would continue to be their daily bread, their grace and the zeal of their spirit.

**22** Pray that the full restoration of Phil's foot would bring a great momentum in the Spirit, that he can stand and run naturally and spiritually. Pray for continued and increased support for their ministry to feed into the momentum.

12 Pray for those on the front lines of persecution, to know their calling and purpose, to know the companionship of Holy Spirit, and to press on toward the heavenly prize.

13 Pray that persecution would do a refining work in believers, and bring much strength of spirit and fruitfulness of character and deed.

14&15 Pray that the love of God would continue to keep, motivate and energise His people for service. Pray that this living love in His people would touch hearts, draw and transform people.

## KENYA

16 Release double portion faith for Phil and Sarah. Declare abundance, Holy Spirit guidance, wholeness, excellence, good rest, and good people around them.

17 Pray for angelic guard around Phil and Sarah's family and dwelling place. Pray for a tangible increase in the Presence of God around their day to day lives, dwelling in their home and in their hearts. Pray they are themselves a place of praise, of grace and of peace from the Lord. Pray that this kingdom of peace be extended across their community and nation.

18 Pray for the young boys that Phil ministers to, many full of trauma. Pray they see Jesus and the love of the Father, and be called out of death and destruction into a redeemed life of hope, forgiveness and purpose.

20 Pray that youth would boldly rise up and speak the Truth, and expose lies and darkness.

21&22 Pray that any spirit of heaviness and cloud of darkness trying to suppress the work of God would be broken in praise. Invite heaven over God's people, every blessing on them that was paid for at the cross. Pray for new zeal, fire and momentum in the Holy Spirit.

23 Pray for unity in the Spirit and in prayer.

24 Pray for divine presence to manifest in every gathering of believers.

25 Pray that the stirring and shaking of the Lord, though perhaps messy and uncomfortable, would be embraced for healing, as people trust and drink deeply of His love and goodness.

## NEW ZEALAND

26 Pray for those who have recently heard about Jesus through evangelism around the country, that they would continue to be drawn to the Lord and respond to Holy Spirit. Pray that the seeds of the Word of God spoken will take root and bear much fruit.
