Declaring God's Greatest Gift

Only God can inspire a vision for six gospel crusades in a Hindu nation!

Such a vision was entrusted to Pastor Samuel Rai who has a proven record of organising large gospel meetings in his home country, Nepal for 30 years. Only God has a larger love and heartbeat for the salvation of this nation than Dr Samuel Rai.

So it was that after several months of planning and preparation that the Gospel Crusades were held one by one across the nation of Nepal in Kerabari, Udaipur, Damak, Dharan, Pokhara and Chitwan.

Samuel and his team rallied the support and help of 350 churches and assigned a pastor in each area as a point of contact. So the churches worked together beautifully to get the Christmas message across to the people in their area.

Incredibly 21,500 people from many different tribes and ethnic backgrounds heard the good news of Jesus and the hope, love, life and salvation He offers. They were all given the gift of a New Testament with Questions & Answers printed by Samuel's faithful and loyal team of helpers.

They heard that Jesus is God's greatest gift to mankind. That His birth was the beginning of God's rescue plan for humanity, that Jesus brought salvation and freedom to those who trust Him. Not a political or social freedom, but spiritual and eternal liberty of mind and conscience to every soul that embraces Him.

Pastor Samuel shared a slightly different message at each crusade: that through faith in Jesus there is a peace that surpasses all understanding even in difficult times. Jesus

birth was the beginning of new hope and life that changes hearts and direction for all those who choose to believe.

Some learned that history is centred on Christ. Anno Domini means 'The Year of our Lord', so time itself is divided by Jesus birth which also changed the course of history. He is the Lord of time.

They heard that Christmas is a reminder that God has not abandoned humanity, but that He loves everyone and desires fellowship with His creation.



Jesus' humble beginnings transcends time, culture and all walks of life, from the poor to the rich. There is no division of caste, class or culture in Jesus, only dignity and equality.

Many years ago, the Lord showed Dr Samuel a strategy for holding these large meetings to invite key leaders in each region to attend. These crusades were

no different as local government chairpersons or representatives, Animist leaders, Hindu and Buddhist leaders or chairmen of associations, Members of Parliament, City or Deputy Majors and school teachers to name a few were invited to the crusades. Incredibly, these key leaders received a New Testament and heard the Gospel of Jesus!

We pray the life and love of Jesus will infiltrate their hearts and minds and bring repentance and salvation to some if not all these leaders and those who attended the crusades.

Contending with the Powers of Darkness

Witchcraft in most parts of Africa dominates the culture, requiring the blood of humans, chickens, goats, cows, sheep. It is a culture of death, unforgiveness, revenge and seeking curses on any who cause annoyance.

Pastor John shares his story: "This evil practice surrounded our home and despite my father being a devout Catholic who helped build a Catholic church, he still believed in witchdoctors. They would cut my skin to make it bleed. then mix the blood with either a chicken. goat or ram. This was meant to be my protection against demons.

But it didn't stop the torment I suffered every night as a child when I had a cruel, recurring dream where a woman would grab and drag me into her grave. My parents took me to every witch doctor they could to be set free. But none of their wicked practices would work. When I was 13, my older brother suggested I attend an outdoor Christian crusade to hear about Jesus. The Pastor offered to pray for anyone suffering from nightmares. That was me! After prayer, I went to bed I had the best sleep ever. Had the demons forgotten to torment me? I waited one, two, three nights – no more nightmares! I was so happy to be delivered from those terrifying dreams.

I became a born-again Christian and the Word of God was my constant comfort. My polygamous father had several wives who were wicked stepmothers to me, riddled with jealousy, and enjoyed making my life miserable. They hated my new faith in God. When I heard Matthew 28:11 where Jesus invites us to come to Him, I gladly off-loaded all my pain and troubles to Him. Matthew 10:21-23 was a great encouragement to me especially when my father expelled me from my home at 17 years old because I had become a Christian. It was this scripture that gave me the faith and courage to flee to another city, knowing Jesus would be with me.

As a very poor Pastor, watching our three little girls searching for food in the rubbish bin, I cried to God for 10 years, asking for Him to send us help. He gave me Isaiah 46:9-11 and I knew when Bruce and Margaret came from far away New Zealand, God was fulfilling this scripture. They became 'Cyrus' to me.

December 25th is a busy day in many parts of Africa, but not because they celebrate the birth of Jesus. Instead it is to go to the grave of a loved one and command "My father hear me. My mother hear me. Put a curse on..." In their culture, it is the blood that provides a lifelong 'point of contact' with the dead.

But God counters that evil culture by giving us Jesus who bled and died once and for all for us. It's the Blood and Name of Jesus which is above all other names that sets us free and gives us eternal life, peace and hope!"

Born again, Holy Spirit filled Pastors in Africa are constantly challenged by witchcraft, a concept which is so hard for us to grasp and believe here in the west.

Praise God for the thousands who are turning to Jesus as they realise that witchcraft leaves them tormented, weak, sick, impoverished, alone. Africa is so desperate for Jesus!

We believe and declare that God will build His church according to Matthew 16:18 "I will build My church and all the powers of hell shall not prevail against it!"

From large to small, humble Pentecostal churches, Ugandans gather as often as they can to pray, intercede for their nation and Africa to be liberated from witchcraft. They sing, dance, shout to the honour and glory of the Lord Who has delivered them from evil and given them His deepest love, joy, peace and self-control! They prevail by prayer, fasting and worshipping together, being in agreement, seeking harmony and unity and teaching and preaching God's Word.

Having bibles has been a tremendous help and blessing in empowering the church to overcome witchcraft in this nation. Ugandan Pastors and church leaders are deeply grateful for all the support Mission Outreach provides through funds for Bibles.



God's Word "is a lamp to their feet and a light to their path" (Psalm 119:105) leading them away from the deception of witchcraft so embedded in the culture, and founding them in the hope and life that only Jesus gives.

There is still a great need for bibles in this nation and the many other nations Mission Outreach supports with the Word of God.

Bibles encourage, strengthen and empower the Church of God everywhere they are given. Some pastors has said it is a fighting tool against the powers of darkness, just as much as worship, prayer and intercession are.

Please continue to pray for our brethren in Uganda who are contending with the powers of darkness that the glory and hope of Jesus will infiltrate such darkness with light and truth.

'For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. (Ephesians 6:12)

Hope for the Young Women

In so many nations throughout the world, women are often treated as second class citizens or worse. In poorer nations and regions, many do not have the opportunity to be educated or trained in any way. They are often given manual labouring jobs, or getting married off young and often end up in very unhappy situations.

When the Lord gave Pastor Samuel a vision of how to help change this in Nepal, he embraced the idea with great enthusiasm and began planning how to achieve God's vision.

So it was that approximately ten years ago, the Deborah Sewing Training Programme began and young women from remote villages throughout Nepal were invited to apply. During the training they learn how to sew as well as the art of tailoring along with basic health care and first aid. They also study the bible and learn the basics of a life of prayer, faith and discipleship.

This prepares them for being able to start a small sewing business in their village and how to use it to tell others about Jesus. When they graduate they are given a treadle sewing machine to enable them start their own business back in their home village and provide for themselves and help their family as they come from very poor areas where there is little or no opportunity for an education or income.



Above is the 41st batch of the young women who have just started their Sewing & Bible Training course in Pokhara, Nepal. Following are testimonies from two of these young women:

My name is **Rita Chepang** from Ainas Rural Municipality and Sinai Bhanjyang Church. My family came from Hindu cultural background. There are 11 members in my family, father, mother, 4 elder brother, 2 young brother, 2 sisters and me. I was born on 5 December 2007.

Before we became Christian we used to worship idols and practice other activities whatever other Hindu people are doing. My family became Christian when my big brother got married but he did not have children for a long time.



We did all activities according to Hindu culture and tradition of sacrificing birds and animals, but nothing happened. One day my sister-in-law heard about Jesus Christ and she believed in Jesus and prayed for a child. Since then she has had a son and a daughter. Seeing the blessing from God, my parents also believed in Jesus Christ and I learned that Jesus has come to forgive my sin.

I accepted Jesus Christ as my personal saviour on 5 Dec 2021 and was baptized on 3 March 2024. I attended church regularly and wanting an opportunity to go bible school to learn more about God.

One day I heard about the Deborah Bible and Sewing Training from our church Pastor. This excited me as I was interested in learning to sew and make clothes but had no chance in my life. When I heard the training was free I knew it was an opportunity for me as I could not afford to pay.

After completing this training I would like to start a small shop and sell dresses and create new clothing designs to earn money for my daily needs and help my church and family. Please pray for me and my ministry.

My name is **Samita Chepang** and I am from Taarbang Rural Municipality, Dhading. I was born on 6 Dec 2007 and go to Sinai Bhanjyang Church. There are 7 members in my family and we came from Hindu background. We did not get peace and joy even though we practiced the idol worship and animal sacrifices required by Hinduism to get peace and joy. None of these helped.



My father became a Christian first when my big brother was very sick. We took him to the witch doctor and hospital for treatment but nothing happened. Around that time, my father heard about the Gospel from an evangelist and that Jesus can heal any kind of sickness if we believe in His name. After hearing this, my father shared the good news and we called a Christian to our home who prayed for my brother. My brother healed slowly day by day, he got better. Because of his healing we believed in Jesus.

There was no church in our village so we would walk to another village to have church fellowship. My parents and brother accepted Jesus as their personal savior and took water baptism. I accepted Jesus as my personal savior on 26 November 2021 and was baptized in water on 3 March 2024.

I heard about the Deborah Bible Training from our Pastor. My Pastor encouraged me to join the training for Bible study and women's skill development, sewing and primary health education. I prayed and decided to go. I am hoping to learn more of God's word and how to sew and design clothes. After this training I will go back to my church and do ministry among women. Please pray for me.

PEARL22

1 Pray for finances to meet the needs for bibles, and increase of scope and impact of the Word.

PURIM

2 Jews celebrate deliverance from Haman's planned genocide at Esther's bold request. Pray for encounters with their Messiah as they celebrate and honour His salvation.

RAMADAN

3 This important muslim time of prayer and fasting extends from 17th February to 20th March. Pray that every person humbly seeking for truth and holiness would encounter Jesus, especially muslim leaders. Pray that every place of worship would become a place of encounter with Jesus.

4 Pray that those falling short of this holy expectation to observe Ramadan, would be caught up in the grace and hope of God, and rejoice in a life of faith in Jesus.

PERSECUTED CHURCH

5 Pray for our brethren in persecuted nations such as Islamic nations, China, North Korea, Myanmar and others. Pray that their spirits would remain deeply rooted in the precious love of Jesus, that their souls would not faint, and they would continue to love the Lord with all their heart, soul, mind and strength.

NEW YEAR

6 As followers of the Hindu religion (especially in India and Nepal) celebrate their New Year, pray for a newness to come on their hearts to be moved towards the one true living God. Pray that gospel radio such as LifeTalk in New Zealand would reach the ears of those hungry for truth and for impacting encounters with the Lord that would change the course of their lives.

7 As those in Afghanistan and Iran prepare to celebrate and reflect on the Persian New Year, declare the (Isa 61) new year of the Lord's favour. Pray boldness on believers, anointed with Holy Spirit to carry the gospel of the Kingdom from heaven to earth.

IRAN

8&9 Pray for strength for the people fighting against the regime. Pray the regime would be spiritually disarmed and overthrown. Pray that righteous leadership would be raised up, that the nation would be exalted. Pray for a return to the early Christian roots, and an embracing of the gospel.

NEPAL

10 Pray for all workers in GTN as they print, plan and teach in BBC and Deborah training, and Emmanuel School. Pray for all preparations to be led of the Holy Spirit. Pray for Samuel and Mangali for encouragement and capacity to continue in the work.

11 Pray that children would be blessed in the knowledge of the Lord their Maker, and grow up in the instruction of the Lord and learning to hear His Spirit.

CHILDREN

12 Pray for angelic protection over children. Pray each of them encounter Jesus at a young age. Those who have already suffered trauma, pray for restoration and deep healing. Pray they become powerful ambassadors for the Kingdom of God. Help God's people working with children to represent Him well.

COLOMBIA

13 Pray for the establishment of Children of Prisoners program through Prison Fellowship Colombia. Pray that "candles of light" and truth would disarm the spiritual darkness, and bring a welcome hope and peace.

15&16 Night of Power is when it is believed that Mohammed received his revelation from heaven. Pray hunger for truth increases and that Holy Spirit would come in power to reveal Jesus the Word, in whom all things have their meaning and existence.

PHILIPPINES

17 Pray for favourable weather for crops to grow well, even as the Body of Christ prospers in unity and humility. Pray for even greater intimacy with God.

18 Pray for Jeth and team as they do gospel outreach, as they operate in unity and love, not one soul will be lost.

PERSECUTED CHURCH

19 Pray for divine wisdom, boldness and Holy Spirit fire. Pray for angelic protection on all those suffering through persecution because of their faith in Jesus.

KENYA

20 Continue to uplift Phil and Sarah and their young family in Nairobi, for the Presence of God, that the Lord would overflow from them to those they minister to. Pray for every need to be met for them and for those they minister to.

21&22 Pray for the young men at the farm that they also would take the opportunity to put their roots down deep in who God created them to be, to receive deep love, peace and hope, and build their lives on faith in Christ.

Pray that although there may have been storms and trouble, God is ready to build on the foundation with beauty and strength, fruitfulness and expansion, and promises fulfilled.

27 Pray every new vision will have a strong foundation.

NEW ZEALAND

28&29 Pray for financial breakthrough for Lifetalk Ethnic Radio. Pray for a blessing on the equipment, opportunities and labourers for the work. Release divine health to both Robinson and Esther.

30 Pray for Ps John's son-in-law Jaze, for healing from a head injury 6 months ago. Break trauma off his body and release the peace and healing of heaven over his whole being.

31 Pray for the NZ church would walk by faith and not fall prey to religious spirits. Ask Holy Spirit to soften hearts and open the way for freedom from the slavery of religion, and show what the Kingdom of God is truly like.

PASSOVER

1 As leaven is removed from the house in preparation for Passover, pray for reflection and repentance from sin, as revealed by Holy Spirit.

2 As Jews and Christians eat the seder meal, pray for Holy Spirit to reveal the victory of Blood of the Lamb over certain death, fulfilled in Jesus Christ. Pray that in meditations on the Word, Holy Spirit would come and bring revelation.

GOOD FRIDAY

3 Pray for Holy Spirit to draw many to church to find the truth of the Saviour given for them. Pray for all Easter outreaches to find multitudes of hearts ready to receive the Kingdom of God.

RESURRECTION SUNDAY

4&5 Pray that celebrations of resurrection of Jesus from the dead would dispel the deception of all false gospels and religions. Pray that there would be a mass move of true repentance, and a mass release from bondage to religion, across the nations.

PASSOVER

6 Pray that in celebrating the parting of the Red Sea, believers would live from foundations of faith in the Way Maker, and be water baptised into this new life of faith, relinquishing the past and embracing the Lord Jesus.

PEARL 22

7 Pray for a deeper hunger for truth in the earth. Pray that every desire for the Word would be filled, and every hungry soul would be nourished and strengthened in the Word.

KENYA

8 Praise God for the fruit of Phil and Sarah's sacrifice, for every life that is touched with love, hope and opportunity, destiny and dignity. Pray for their family for healing, wisdom and peaceful rest, and a suitable place to call home. Pray for increased capacity as they take on more responsibilities for the mission.

MUSLIM WORLD

9 Pray that Jesus would continue to appear to people in dreams and visions and in mosques. Pray that the truth would expose the lies and people would come out from under deception.

INDIA

10 Pray for Pastor E for continued covering in the work of the Lord, anointing and encouragement of partners in the ministry. Pray that every need will be met, as she seeks first God's Kingdom and righteousness.

11&12 Praise God for 1000 bibles distributed earlier this year. Pray for every soul saved would grow in faith and maturity as they feed on the Word. Praise God for 100 home churches started in 2 years. Pray for another 100 home churches to be established this year.

CAMBODIA

13 Pray for Kingdom come to Cambodia and Thailand, that where there was much war and tension, will be now no more destruction but built with salvation and praise. (Isa 60:17). Pray for unity among leaders to bring healing and hope.

14 Pray that those who have lost homes to the military would be put in families, and homes would be restored to them.

15 Pray for divine strategy and favour for Sabun as he expands Prison Fellowship into more prisons. Pray that he and the team would flourish in this time of increase.

16 Praise God for 1000 gospels of Luke given out to prisoners as part of "the Listeners Way" program. Bless all involved in this program and declare the purposes of God to all receiving the Word.

17 Pray for God's people to be positioned to influence and inspire others, to ignite hearts in passionate pursuit of Jesus and what He moves on them to do.

PERSECUTED CHURCH

18&19 Pray that the witness of the faithfulness of believers in the face of persecution would be the spirit of prophecy to the nations, bringing many more to faith.

20 Pray for successful smuggling of bibles into restricted nations. Pray that seeing eyes be made blind and operations remain hidden from opposing forces. Pray for protection over vehicles and fuel that doesn't run out. Bless every person involved and their families.

GLOBAL

21 Pray that where there has been sorrow, grief and devastation, that hearts would be humbled and softened to seek and respond to the Lord.

22 Pray against the anti Jew narrative. Pray for teachers to rise up and speak the truth. Pray for people to be free of deception and have the wisdom to seek after truth.

AFRICA

23 Praise God for Pastor John's recent outreach with Brian from NZ. Pray that seeds of faith would grow in the people who were reached and they would become strong "oaks of righteousness", mature and expanding the Kingdom of God.

24 As people journey with the Lord and the family of believers, pray that every thorn of offense would be dealt with and healed quickly, so as not to hinder the Spirit.

ANZAC

25&26 Pray that honour of sacrifice would be rightfully given but also go beyond the ANZAC soldiers to the acknowledgement of One who willingly gave up His life for His enemies. Pray that people would encounter this Jesus and give Him their Yes.
