The Hope of Israel

The Holy Bible is not a relic of the past; it is an enduring spiritual compass guiding our steps through our past, present, and future. At the centre of its divine narrative stands Israel, God's chosen people, whose rich history and prophetic future are inextricably linked to the grand design of redemption.

From Genesis onward, God set apart a nation to reveal Himself to the world. Every covenant with Moses and David, and every prophetic word from Isaiah to Malachi, points toward a single unfolding purpose culminating in Jesus Christ—a Saviour of Jewish origin, born of the line of David, who is both Messiah and Lord. Israel's story is not separate from Christianity; it is its foundational and living root.

In our turbulent world, the stark reality of human depravity is violently evident, most profoundly underscored by the horrific October 7, 2023, massacre orchestrated by Hamas. On that devastating morning, roughly 7,000 terrorists breached the border to perpetrate unspeakable atrocities, murdering 1,182 people—including helpless infants, entire families, and elderly Holocaust survivors—while injuring over 4,000 and abducting 251 hostages from 44 different nations. Survivors have shared harrowing personal testimonies across news platforms of hiding for hours in silence and listening to loved ones perish. Shockingly, much of the



mainstream media and international discourse has consistently downplayed this horrific violence, sliding into an institutional anti-Semitic bias and a culture of denialism that began while the victims were still dying. This persistent minimization deepens the trauma of survivors whose courageous personal accounts demand that the global community never forgets.

Yet, amid the profound darkness of global violence and rising anti-Semitic hostility, a remarkable spiritual renewal is quietly unfolding. According to research from the Caspari Centre, the Messianic movement in Israel has more than tripled over the last two decades, growing from

approximately 5,000 believers in 1999 to tens of thousands today. Worldwide, Messianic Jewish leaders report an even broader expansion, rising from roughly 350,000 believers in 2012 to nearly one million now.

Danny and Lily are faithful workers in the Mission Field of the Philippines. Following is a recent report from them.

We continue ministering in three schools and have a daily feeding program in the largest school of 249 students. Most of our resources go into raising chickens and pigs, which we use to feed the students. These will be ready in a few more weeks. It is our hope that our resources may increase in order to provide a feeding program to the other two schools.

We are very blessed that some of the students who graduated have now returned to teach and work at the schools. So far two schools have Mangyan teachers who came from us. Another school, farther up the hill has a teacher who came from us too and is also asking for a feeding program for their students. May God supply all our needs!

We are ever grateful to our Father for the life we have in Him - His blessings of peace, joy, strength, good health, protection and so much more we enjoy as His beloved children.

No Longer Alone

Living in Afghanistan under the pressure of the Taliban, family sickness and financial strain, one woman cries out to God for help. Here is her story, told by her believing friend.

"I shared the good news of God with my neighbour. This woman lives under very difficult circumstances. Her husband is sick, their financial situation is bad, and she always felt broken and guilty inside. Every night she fell asleep worried and woke up sad and feeling alone.

One day I visited her, and she cried a lot and said she was tired of her life. I told her that she needed to have hope in God and that one day her problems would be solved. She said, 'I pray all the time, but I feel like my prayers are going nowhere.' In her deepest sorrow, she said, 'God, if You are real, show Yourself to me... I'm so tired.'

That night she had a strange dream. She was in a dark desert, cold, scared, and alone with no way out. Suddenly she saw a light in the distance. The light came

closer and she saw a man in bright clothes. His face was full of peace. When she looked at Him, all her fear disappeared. The man said, 'Don't be afraid, I'm with you.' She asked, 'Who are you?' He answered, 'I am the Son. I am the way, the truth and the life.'

When she woke up, her heart was beating fast, but not with fear. From that day on, her life slowly changed. Her problems didn't stop right away, but her outlook on life changed. She no longer felt sad or lonely.



Later, she began to learn about who 'The Son' is. The more she read the Bible, the more she felt that it was the same person as in her dream. Finally, she decided to believe in the Son of God-Jesus. Often people find answers in their most difficult moments, and not in

the way they expect or hope, but in a way that changes their hearts and lives forever.

PEARL 22

1 Praise God that the bibles have arrived safely. Thank God for His protection over the men and vehicles transporting them. As the bibles are distributed, pray God's continued protection on all involved and the Word would get into the right hands.

2 Declare that the Word of God sent forth would accomplish God's purpose in transforming people, cities and nations. Pray that the multiplication of souls will be like a ripple effect in all areas of life in these nations.

3 Pray for the work of Mission Outreach to expand and flow like a river of life to the nations. Pray for God to open doors to more nations and contacts for bible distribution and for support in prayer and finances to fulfil every project.

HEALTH

4 Praise God that He has already paid the price for healing on the cross of Calvary, that the work is finished. By His stripes we are healed. Give praise for the healing that is already taking place and will take place.

5&6 Pray for those who may be frustrated by the limitations of their bodies, and for a deeper level of trust in their Lord. Pray for the strength to be able to fulfil His call on their lives and for complete healing in their bodies.

7 Pray for all missionaries to rest in Him and for His grace to fulfil God's work, having no confidence in the flesh but knowing their God will supply all their needs, that they live not by might but by His Spirit.

PERSECUTED CHURCH

8 Bless and lift up our brothers and sisters in restricted nations. Pray for God's peace, grace, protection and strength, and a refreshment of the Holy Spirit. Pray the Lord will have mercy on those suffering at the hands of their persecutors, that the days of their incarceration will be shortened.

9 Praise God that no authority of man can stop the move of the Holy Spirit. Bless His work with men and women behind closed doors. Declare Jesus will build His Church, and complete what He has begun.

10 Pray for those that minister for the Lord, that there be unity and oneness in their ministry, their church and their leadership. Release blessing and multiplication over them. Pray for protection over them and their families. Pray God will fill their mouth with the words to speak with boldness.

KENYA

11 Pray for a powerful move of God's Holy Spirit in Kenya - for signs, wonders and miracles where Jesus is being declared. Pray for great boldness for believers.

12&13 Pray for all the boys at the vocational and discipleship farm that they would have fresh encounters with Jesus. Pray for revival amongst these boys, that their lives would be so transformed they would have a great impact on their friends and family.

14 Praise God for the boys who have been baptized recently at the farm. Pray that they go from strength to strength, glory to glory in the Lord. Pray for strong foundations in their life of faith, love, forgiveness, peace and God's presence with them. Pray for deliverance, fresh hope and a desire to share the gospel of Jesus with others.

15 Continue to pray for Phil and Sarah and their children for good health and every provision. Declare the windows of heaven be open, and the abundant provision of the Lord. Herald the kindness and favour of the Lord over them. Pray for the means to have a much needed holiday in NZ with their family, and for inner and outer refreshment and restoration.

16 Pray that they can rejoice in their circumstances, and continue to keep their eyes on the Lord and see the challenges as opportunities for God. Pray their hearts stay on fire and hungry for the Lord.

MUSLIM WORLD

17 Thank God for the revival happening in Iran and amongst the Iranian refugees in camps in Afghanistan. Pray that the hope and love of Christ will flow throughout the Middle East and bring with it a powerful move of God.

18 Pray that followers of Islam would question its authority. Pray Holy Spirit would give them a deep hunger for truth, for love and for peace. Pray as they sincerely search with all their heart, they would find the Living God. Agree for them to encounter Jesus in dreams and visions.

GLOBAL CHURCH

19&20 Pray for leaders, that they would have fresh revelation, vision and hearts seeking truth. Pray for fresh baptism of Holy Spirit and fire. Pray for wisdom in discipleship and training. Pray for boldness.

21 Pray for perseverance, character and faith to stand in times of great difficulty.

SE ASIA

22 Pray that the light of revival would spread into Thailand, Vietnam, Laos and Malaysia. Pray for the church across Southeast Asia, that God connect and draw them together. Pray for unity in the body of Christ in the fear of God by the power of the Spirit.

23 As the volcanoes continue to erupt in Indonesia, ask that the Spirit would flow throughout those islands, into the villages and cities. Pray for the church there to reach out with mercy and the love of God to those who have lost their home or family members. Pray for healing to the nation.

24 Pray that at this uncertain time, many would turn to the Lord, and the seeds that have been sown, would bear fruit. Pray that the Bibles would fall into the hands of many and come alive in them, spreading the fires of revival, renewal and harvest, throughout the nations.

ISRAEL/TABERNACLES

25 The Feast of Tabernacles begins today: Give thanks to God for His provision and sustenance both physically and spiritually. Praise Him that He is a Refuge and Strong Tower in times of trouble.

26&27 Bring your heart and life before the Lord, and ask God to make you a clean "tabernacle" for His Spirit. Ask for a more intimate awareness of His daily presence.

28 As Jesus is our Living Water drink deeply of Him as your greatest need and ask for a fresh infilling of the Holy Spirit.

29 Pray that Israel would not look to man for comfort or trust in their own strength, but would lift up their eyes to their great Yahweh and draw comfort and strength from His promises. Pray they would understand that their great High Priest has already come and paid the price with His own blood once and for all.

30 Pray for wisdom for the government, that they would only tread where God gives permission to tread, and only say what God gives permission for them to say. Pray for such humility to only go "where the Cloud leads", that their lives be encamped around the Presence of God.

OCTOBER 2026

PEARL 22

1 Pray for courageous men and women to break ground in new nations to get the Word of God in there. Pray for Armenia, Albania, Kurdistan and Turkey.

2 Declare that no longer is there a shortage of 'bread' in the house of God. Praise God for His goodness, love and protection. Thank Him that He watches over His word to perform it.

3&4 Declare that every Bible delivered carries Jesus, God's love and the Holy Spirit. Pray that as people read the Word of God, that God will speak to them by His Spirit, touch their heart and move them to obedience.

5 Pray that all those who receive the Word will feed on it and learn to pray and use it powerfully, for God's Word is like fire and like a hammer that shatters rock, and breaks things that need breaking. (Jer. 23:29)

CHILDREN

6 Pray against child trafficking and abuse. Pray for divine interception of every evil intent. Pray strength and favour on anti-trafficking organisations. Pray for strategies of hope for families, communities and nations to be established.

AFRICA

7 Praise God for many faithful missionaries to this continent who have sown for so many years across many borders and glorified the name of the Lord. Pray as Habakkuk did, that the Lord would be famous in our day just as He was in the past.

8 In the places of tyranny where people live by gunfire and the sword, pray for protection on God's children, and for miracles and wisdom. Where many of them have succumbed to great violence, destruction and loss of hope, pray that the Lord would bring comfort.

9 Pray for a powerful move of God's Holy Spirit, that souls will come to repentance again. Pray for the wonderful work of restoration in Africa. Pray that people will rise up with new boldness, new vision, new vigour. Pray that Holy Spirit would move powerfully upon them across the continent.

CAMBODIA

10&11 Pray for the ministry of Prison Fellowship to not be limited in resources, but explode with opportunities and growth. Pray that the gospel would

continue to spread to these dark places, bringing change and restoration.

12 Pray for Jean-Marie who has done prayer teaching in womens' prison. Pray that this teaching would impact the women and girls, their communities and workplaces. Pray for the ongoing impact of the ministry in womens' prisons.

13 Pray for peace upon those that are still in refugee camps, that God would provide a way for them to return to their communities. Pray for churches to take advantage of the doors of opportunity in these camps.

NEPAL

14 Pray for Samuel and Mangali and the GTN team for health and provision of others to share the load of ministry. Pray they have wisdom like Jethro to Moses how they live and minister. Pray for wisdom in how to care for their 'vessels of clay' as they pour out the glory within.

INDIA

15 Pray for God's protection and anointing upon Pastor E. Praise God for her courage and boldness in the midst of opposition. Declare favour on her and that God would surround her with godly men and women. Pray the Word would continue to spread throughout her district.

HEALTH

16 Pray for comfort for those who have lost loved ones and for strength, courage and renewed vision.

17&18 Pray for those with a broken spirit, trauma and pain to be restored and regenerated. Pray for truth to replace lies of hopelessness and the healing love of their Heavenly Father would set them free.

GLOBAL CHURCH

19 Pray for the MO contacts for refreshing in the Spirit. Pray they would operate in the power and might of the Spirit. Pray for wisdom, grace and power.

20 Pray that as God's workers trust in the Lord, His wisdom would shine through. Pray they would submit all plans to Him, their efforts, and success isn't always about numbers, but the work of Christ in the inner man.

21 Pray for God's people to cast the burdens and worries onto Jesus. Pray for submission and being coupled with Jesus in their labour of love.

22 Praise God for many long-term servants of the Lord who are still willing vessels

being used by Him. Thank God that they burn with the fire of the Spirit by the vision they have seen in the Father. Praise God for the momentum and fruitfulness through faithfulness.

PERSECUTED CHURCH

23 Pray seeing eyes are blinded and that anyone with intent to harm or oppose our brothers, that their plans come to nothing. Declare all the schemes of the enemy will fall, and and that God will turn it to good. Bless families and ministries.

24&25 Release the Lord's wisdom over His faithful followers, to have the understanding of what to do in difficult situations. Pray a mantle of the double portion over them.

IRAN

26 Pray that all the scriptures that are in Iran will be in the right place and will impact and change hearts. Pray for protection on every copy and person who receives them.

27 Pray that Word of God will be like arrows going forth and hitting the mark, putting the enemy to flight. Declare the battle belongs to the Lord, for He watches over His Word to perform it.. Agree for pouring out of God's Spirit upon the church.

28 Pray Holy Spirit equip and empower the believers in Iran. Pray for strengthening of the Body of Christ, and for a great revival. Pray that the enemy will be routed. Pray for courage to continue to preach, pray and spread the Word.

NEW ZEALAND

29 Pray for Robinson and Esther and the ministry of LifeTalk Ethnic Radio to the Punjabi and the Hindu people. Pray for encouragement and boldness and increased anointing on Robinson & Esther. Praise God for all He has done in people's lives through this ministry.

30 Pray for God's provision for His vision of LifeTalk Radio. Declare that with joy they draw water (for their needs) from the deep wells of salvation, and they will make known His name among the nations, and proclaim that His name be exalted (above false gods). (Isaiah 12)

31 Pray for softening of hearts that have been hardened against the living God because of the blindness that the enemy has put on their eyes through Hinduism. Declare the turning of souls from false religions to the one true God.
